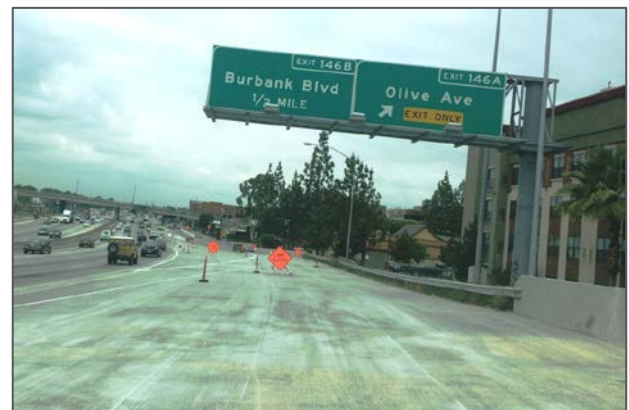

New Northbound I-5 Olive Avenue Off-Ramp in Burbank Now OPEN

BURBANK — Caltrans opened a new northbound I-5 off-ramp at Olive Avenue in Burbank the morning of May 6, 2015. The ramp was reconstructed to accommodate carpool lanes now in construction between State Route 134 and Magnolia Boulevard. The work is part of a \$116 million project that will be completed in 2017. The contractor is Security Paving Co. of Sylmar.

Motorists should expect occasional temporary nighttime closures of the Olive Avenue ramp and others between SR-134 and Magnolia Boulevard as work continues on the carpool lane project.
