



Extra Service on Temporary Letters" will be issued later.

The Scheduled Service Operating Cost Factors Report shows daily vehicle miles, hours and equipment requirements for scheduled transit service. Revenue miles and hours include layovers and intraline deadheads. Interline savings indicate buses that are used on more than one line. Operating Cost Factors reflect the school day service. Temporary service changes for the period since September 13, 1992, will be issued later. Special events service is projected through the end of December.

Rail service statistics are shown both at car and train levels, and are slightly altered to accommodate the gap train operation. Temporary rail service changes for the period since September 13, 1992, will be issued later.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THIS ISSUE:

Lines 10, 14 and 102 had division changes.
Lines 488, 573, and 620 continue to operate only on temporary letters.
Minor route and schedule changes were implemented on several lines to serve Metrolink at Union Station, Glendale, Burbank, and Chatsworth.
