**SUBJECT: MONTHLY UPDATE ON THE TRANSIT POLICING PERFORMANCE**

**ACTION: RECEIVE AND FILE**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Receive and file report the monthly update on the transit policing performance

**ISSUE**

On September 4, 2014, Motion by: Mayor Garcetti, Supervisor Molina, Supervisor Antonovich, ~~and Director Fasana~~ and Director Dupont-Walker requested staff to provide a monthly update on the transit policing performance (criminal activity, fare enforcement, response time, and deployment and perception of safety) to Systems Safety and Operations Committee.

**DISCUSSION**

Staff is providing the following updates to each of the requested items:

Criminal Activity:

- Part 1 Crimes have decreased by 4.5% from January 2014 to July 2014 compared to January 2013 to July 2013 system-wide.
- Overall, buses had an increase of .25% Part 1 crimes per 1,000,000 riders from the same period last year (From 1.35% to 1.60%)

Fare Enforcement:

- In July 2014, law enforcement performed 792,702 fare checks system wide, an increase of 85,157 fare checks compared to June 2014. Metro and LASD are implementing scheduled 100% fare checking strategy throughout the system.

Response Time:

- In July 2014, the average response time for “Calls For Service” (Emergency, Priority, and Routine) for all rail lines, including Silver Line is 19.2 minutes. LASD currently comply with Metro’s Performance Metrics requirement of average 30 minutes for call for service.

Deployment:

- LASD’s deployment is based on their Intelligence Lead Policing (ILP) strategy. From month to month, deputies are redeployed to specific Lines based on the ILP to ensure the safety of the patrons.

Perception of Safety:

- Metro’s Strategic Initiatives department conducts a ridership survey twice a year (May and December) in which the following question is asked of our ridership:
  - Do you feel safe waiting for your rail and/or bus service?
- On a scale of 1 to 4, with 1 being very safe and 4 being not safe at all, the following are the results for the past three years:

|                            | 2012 | 2013 | 2014 |
|----------------------------|------|------|------|
| <b>% of Rail Ridership</b> | 81%  | 82%  | 83%  |
| <b>Mean Score</b>          | 1.92 | 1.88 | 1.88 |
| <b>% of Bus Ridership</b>  | 81%  | 84%  | 83%  |
| <b>Mean Score</b>          | 1.88 | 1.81 | 1.86 |

- 81% or higher of Metro rail and bus riders have responded in the last three years with a 1 or 2 which indicates they feel safe to very safe while waiting for Metro rail and/or bus services.


**NEXT STEPS**

Metro DEO Project Management will work with the Strategic Initiatives department to enhance the ridership survey in order to obtain more data regarding the perception of safety. Metro will also work with LASD in order to establish measurable perception of safety criteria which can then be evaluated. Staff will return monthly to provide performance updates.

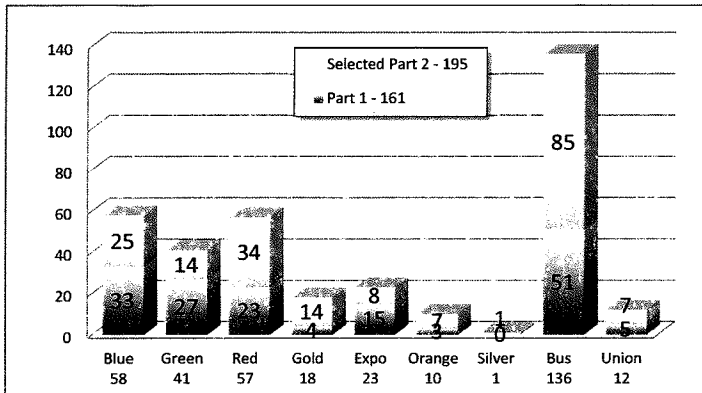

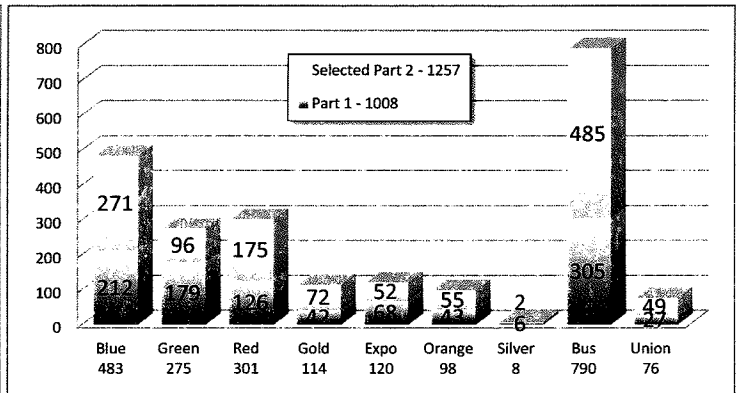

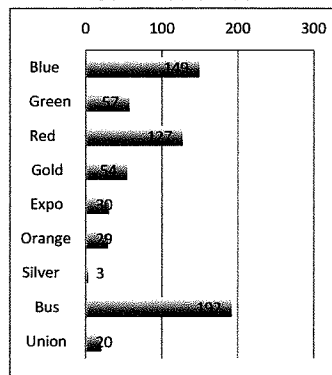
YTD Crimes - 2265



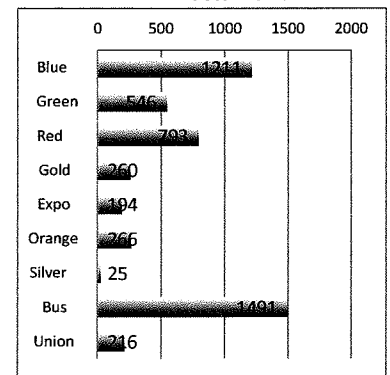

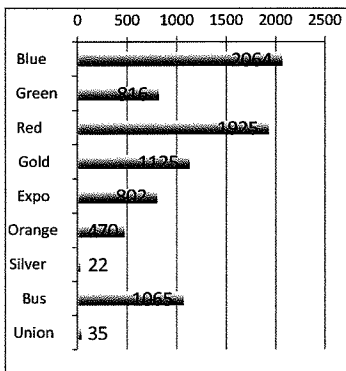
Jul Arrests - 661



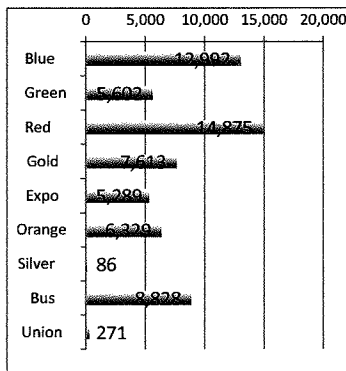
YTD Arrests - 5002



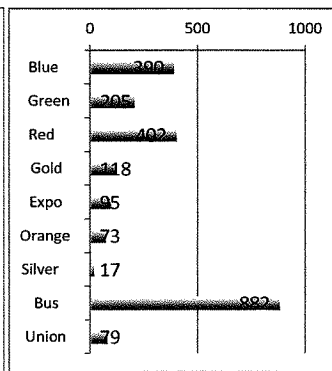
Jul Citations - 8324



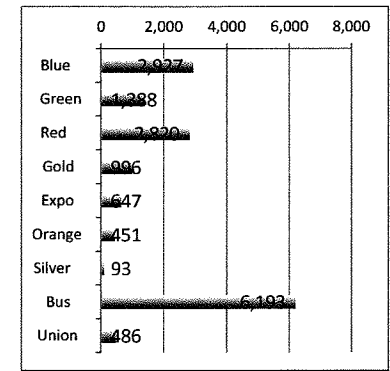
YTD Citations - 61885
