The Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority (Authority) initiated a Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) for the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Phase 2B Project (Project) and hosted a virtual Public Scoping Meeting on June 24, 2020, 5:30 PM – 7:00 PM.

The purpose of the virtual Public Scoping Meeting was to provide an overview of the potential Project Modifications being evaluated by the Authority and to receive public comments on the scope of the SEIR.

The virtual Public Scoping Meeting was held online to comply with local and state COVID -19 social distancing requirements, an in-person scoping meeting was not held. The virtual Scoping Meeting provided a live presentation using the GoToWebinar platform. A total of 165 stakeholders and 12 staff attended the meeting (Appendix D-1 provides a copy of the registrant and attendees list). Formal verbal comments were recorded by a certified court reporter and written comments were received via an electronic comment form. Written comments were also accepted by mail or e-mail. All comments were due to the Authority by July 8, 2020.

The initiation of the SEIR and virtual Public Scoping Meeting were publicized using a variety of methods including, direct outreach to project stakeholders, media and social media outreach, and outreach through partner agencies. Scoping Meeting Notice

The Construction Authority created and distributed a two-page virtual Public Scoping Meeting Notice to announce and solicit input on the Potential Project Modifications. The Notice invited the public to register to join the virtual meeting to learn more about the Potential Project Modifications and provide verbal comments during the meeting or written comments by July 8, 2020. In addition to providing a brief description of the Potential Project Modifications the Scoping Meeting Notice provided details regarding the virtual meeting, directions on how to submit comments, and a link to the NOP. A copy of the Scoping Meeting Notice is included in Appendix D-3 to this memo.

E-News Invitation

The virtual Public Scoping Meeting invitation was distributed through the Foothill Gold Line's E-News starting on June 8, 2020. The E-News reaches more than 12,000 stakeholders who have registered. This electronic medium of sharing information has been used to keep the project database up to date with all major milestones, developments, and construction updates. The E-News featured the virtual Public Scoping Meeting date, time, registration

details, and details on the SEIR. The invitation was emailed on three occasions to invite and remind project stakeholders of the upcoming virtual Public Scoping Meeting and offered assistance for those who weren't familiar with the virtual component.

Agency Coordination

On June 9, 2020, the Construction Authority coordinated with the six corridor cities and associated school districts to ensure the local agencies, businesses, and residential communities were informed of the virtual Public Scoping Meeting and Proposed Project Modifications. To facilitate this effort, the Authority created a virtual Public Scoping Meeting notice that was easy to share via social media and email platforms. The notice was distributed electronically and provided a brief background of the Project status, information regarding the Scoping Meeting's purpose, and relevant information on the Project Modifications.

The Construction Authority forwarded the virtual Scoping Meeting Notice to the agencies listed in Table 2. Corridor city and county libraries including Los Angeles and San Bernardino were sent the notice for distribution and asked to post on their websites or send to their distribution lists. Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 guidelines, no public facilities were open to the public and therefore in-person distribution was not possible.

Construction Authority Website - www.foothillgoldline.org

The Authority's website is designed to provide the latest Project information as well as background on the Authority and earlier Project phases. On June 4, 2020, the scoping meeting notice was placed on the Authority's website under the "What's New" and "Meeting/Events Calendar" sections. Visitors could easily click on the scoping meeting link to read meeting details and instructions on how to submit scoping comments to the Authority. Additionally, to make it easy to find the information, the Authority created a pop-up window that included information about the SEIR and Public Scoping Meeting; the pop-up window would open first to anyone coming to the agency website. It is estimated that 2,405 people visited the Authority's website from June 4, 2020 through June 24, 2020.

Social Media

The virtual Public Scoping Meeting invitation was also published on the Authority's social media platforms, including Facebook, Twitter, and the I Will Ride blog, on June 8, 2020. The Facebook post also included an event that people could RSVP for, using Facebook. The event was posted on June 8, 2020.

According to Facebook's analytics, approximately 10,800 people saw the Facebook post for the scoping meeting on their feed, with 166 people confirming they were attending or interested in attending. According to Twitter's analytics, the Construction Authority's tweets about the scoping meeting appeared approximately 4,400 times in people's Twitter feeds. The I Will Ride blog post on the scoping meeting was sent to 3,038 subscribers of the blog.

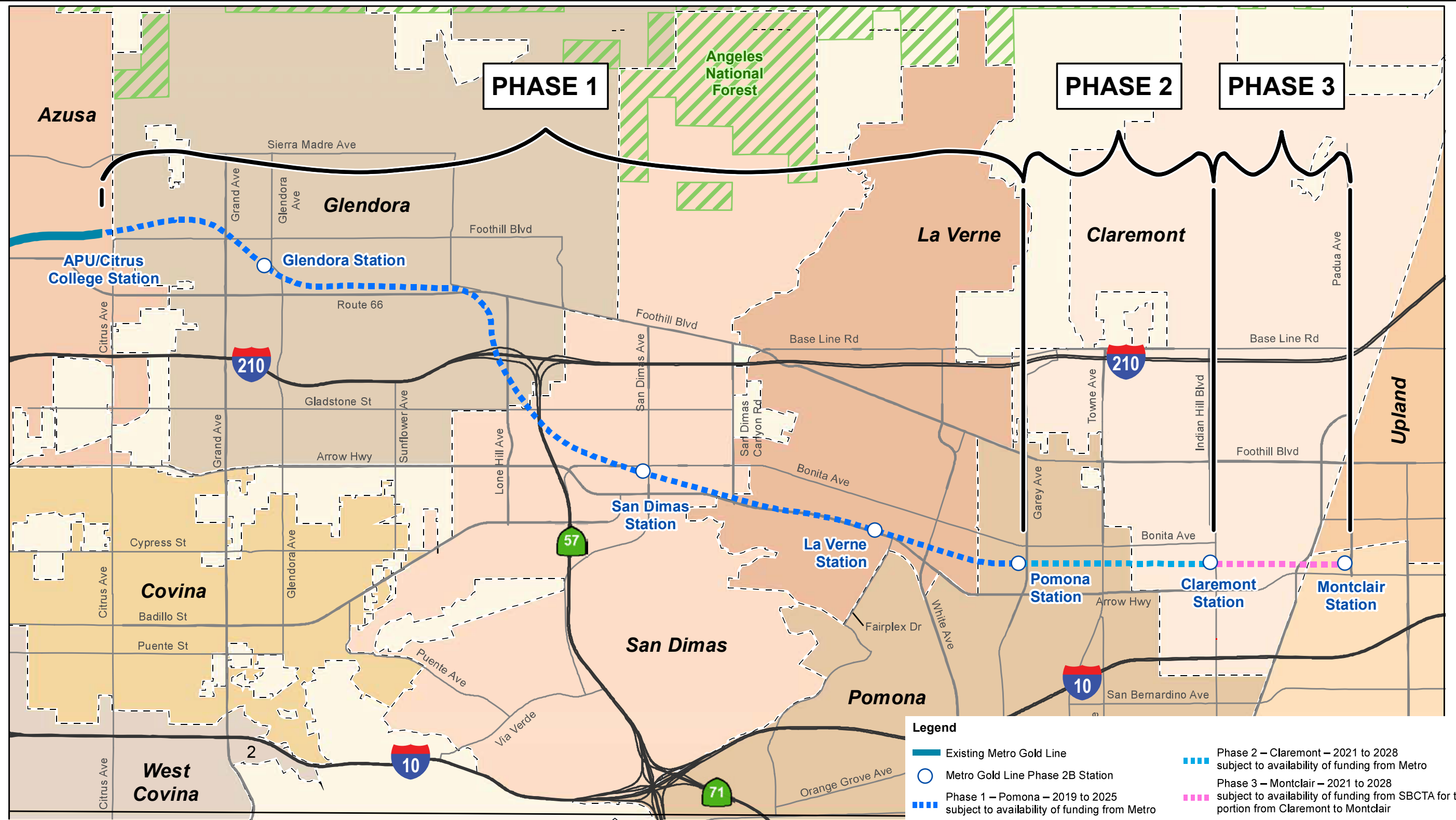

Additional changes are proposed by the Authority that will result in a reduction of parking at the Claremont Station. 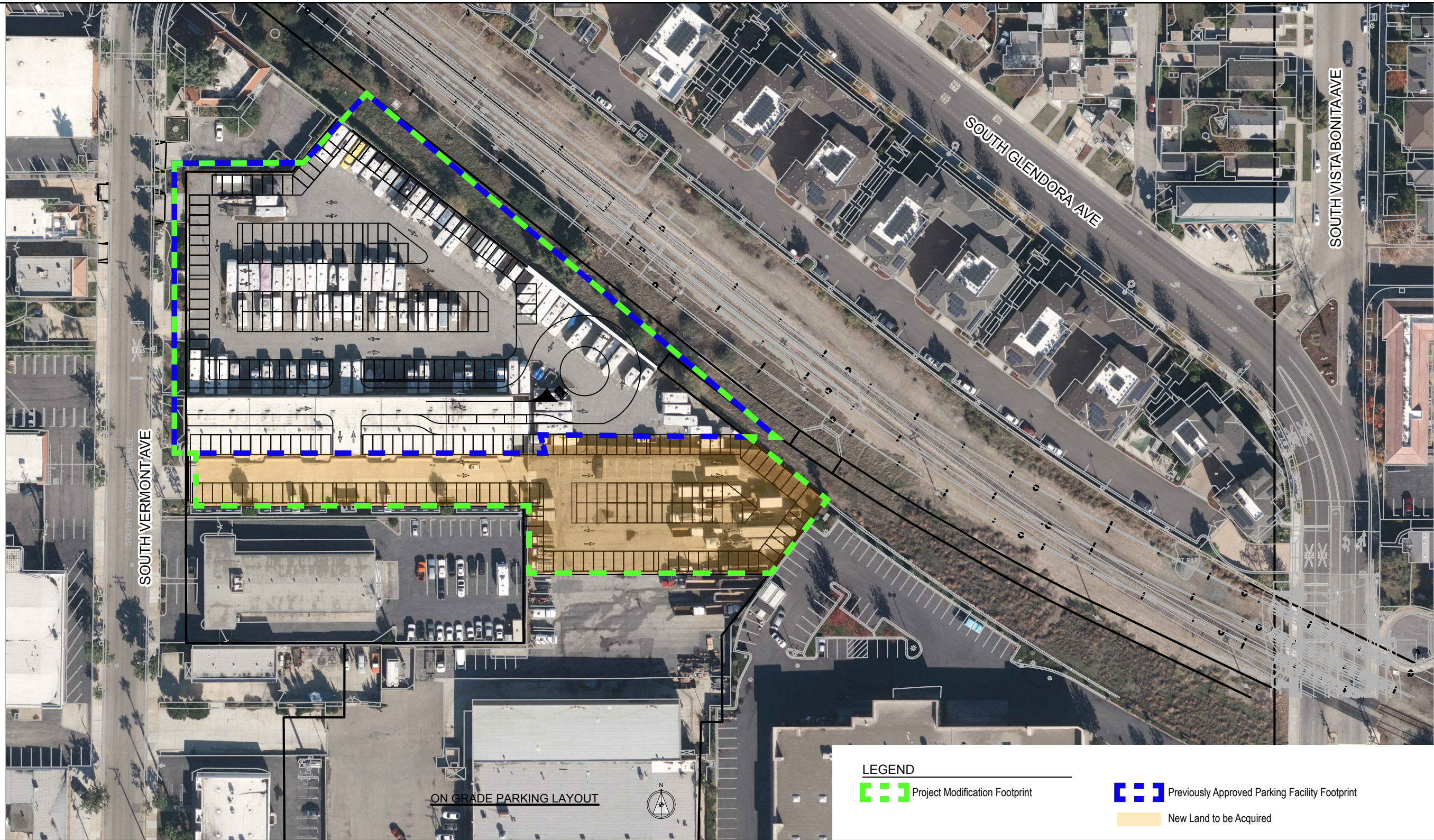

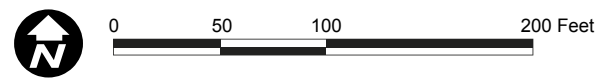
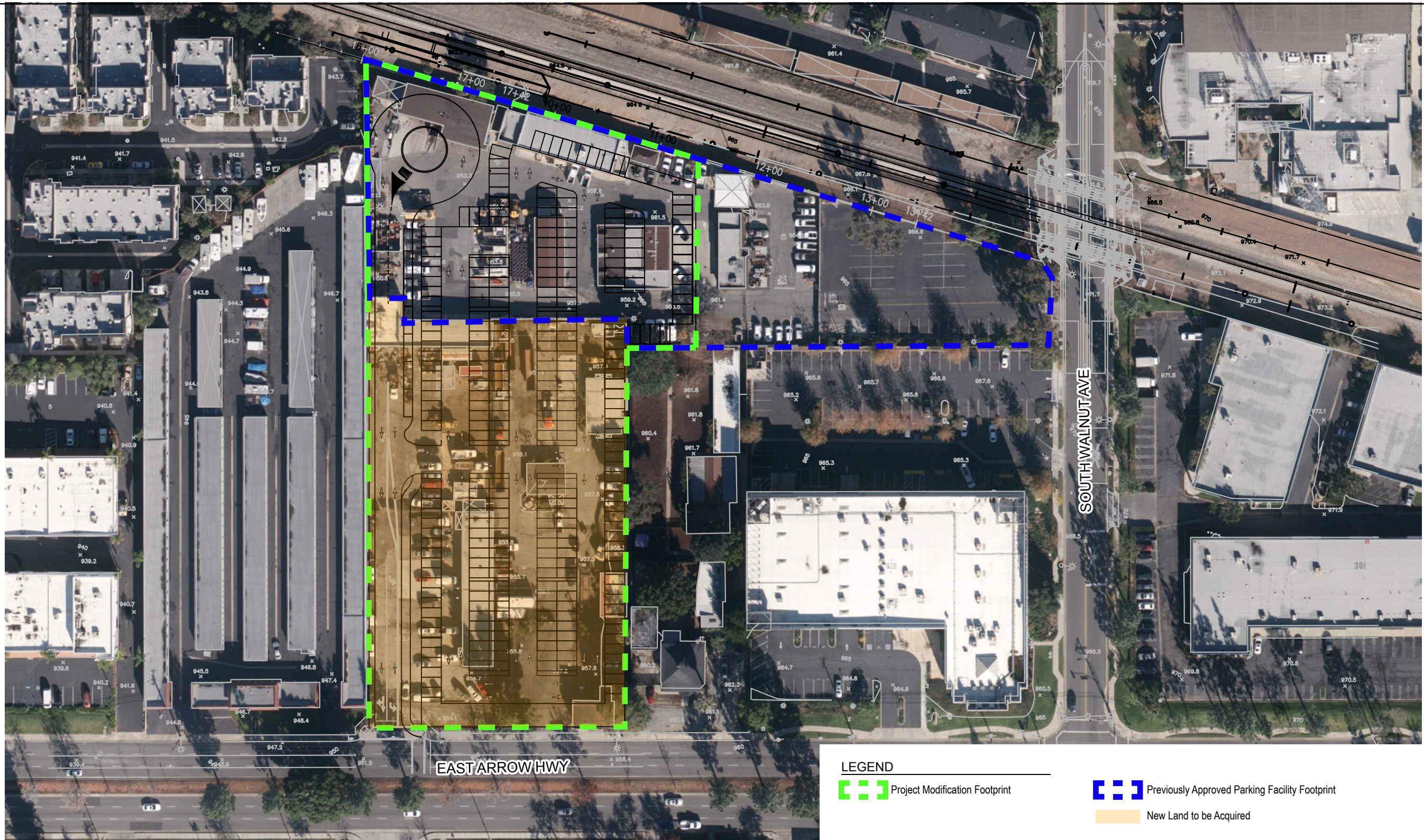


Figure NOP-2

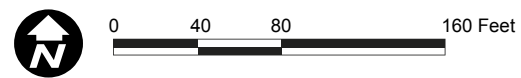
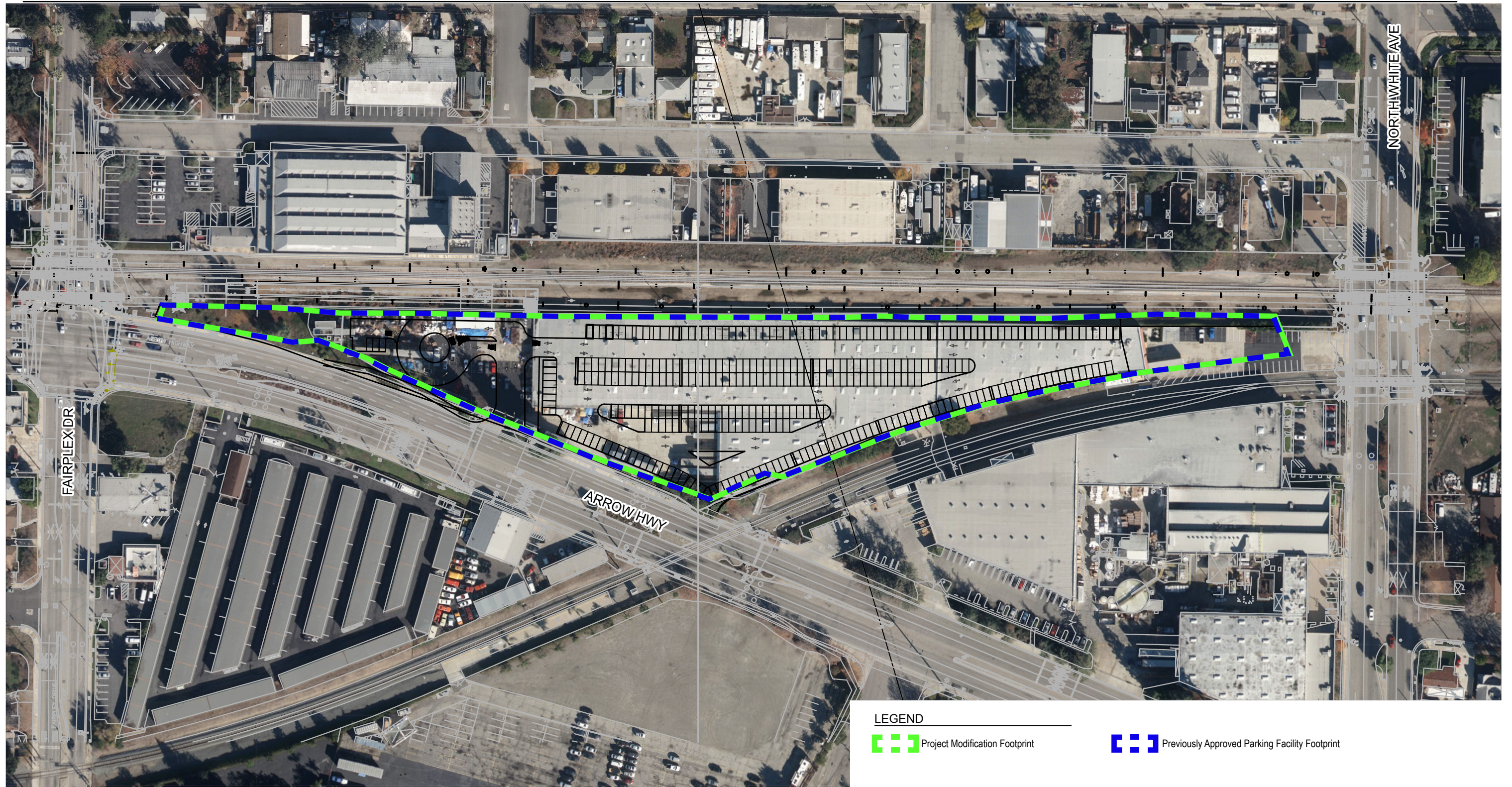


Figure NOP-3

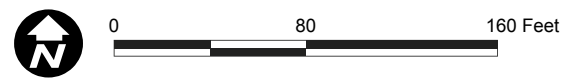
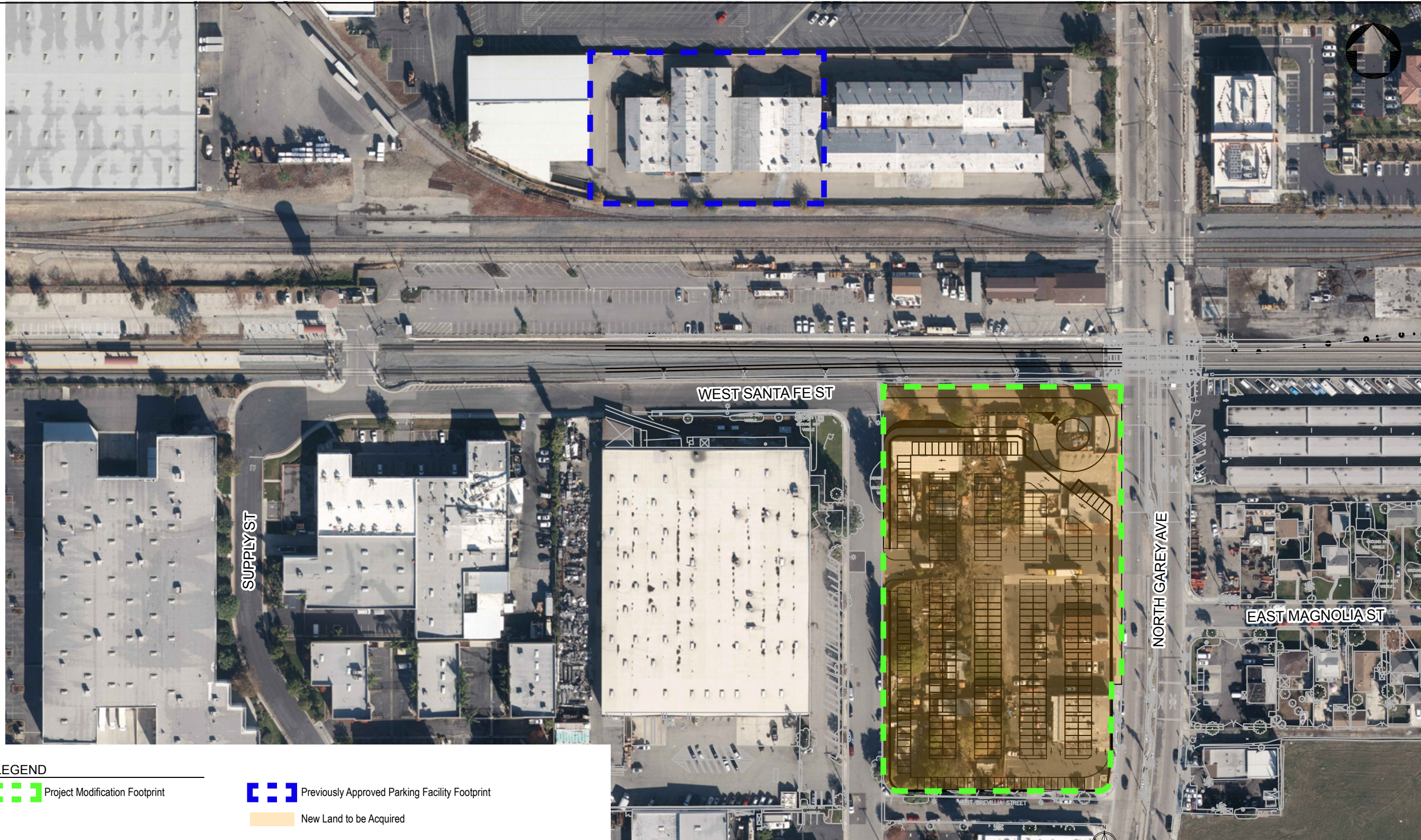


Figure NOP-4

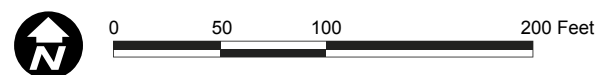
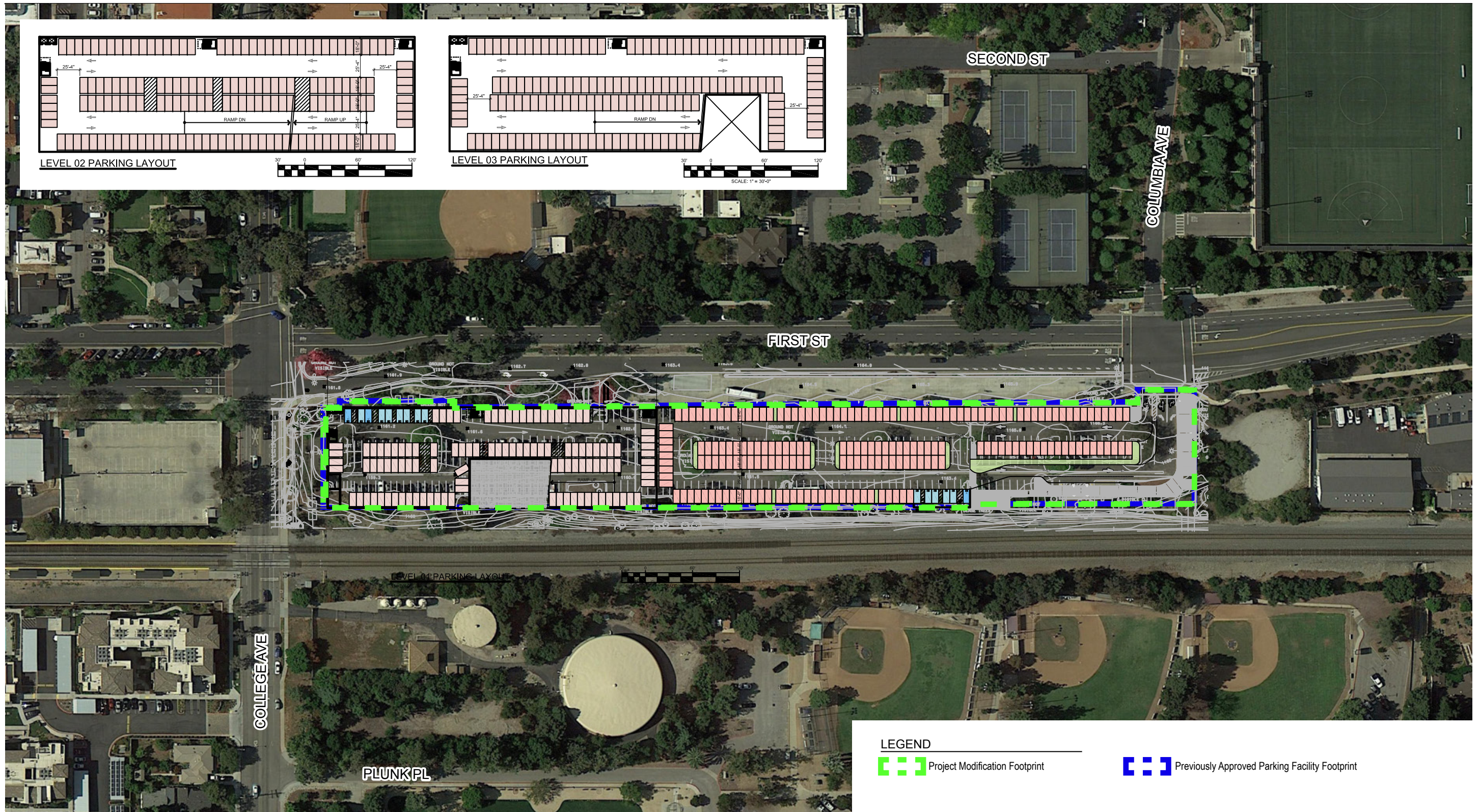


Figure NOP-5

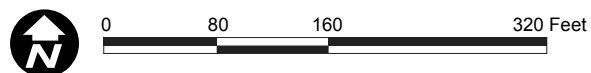
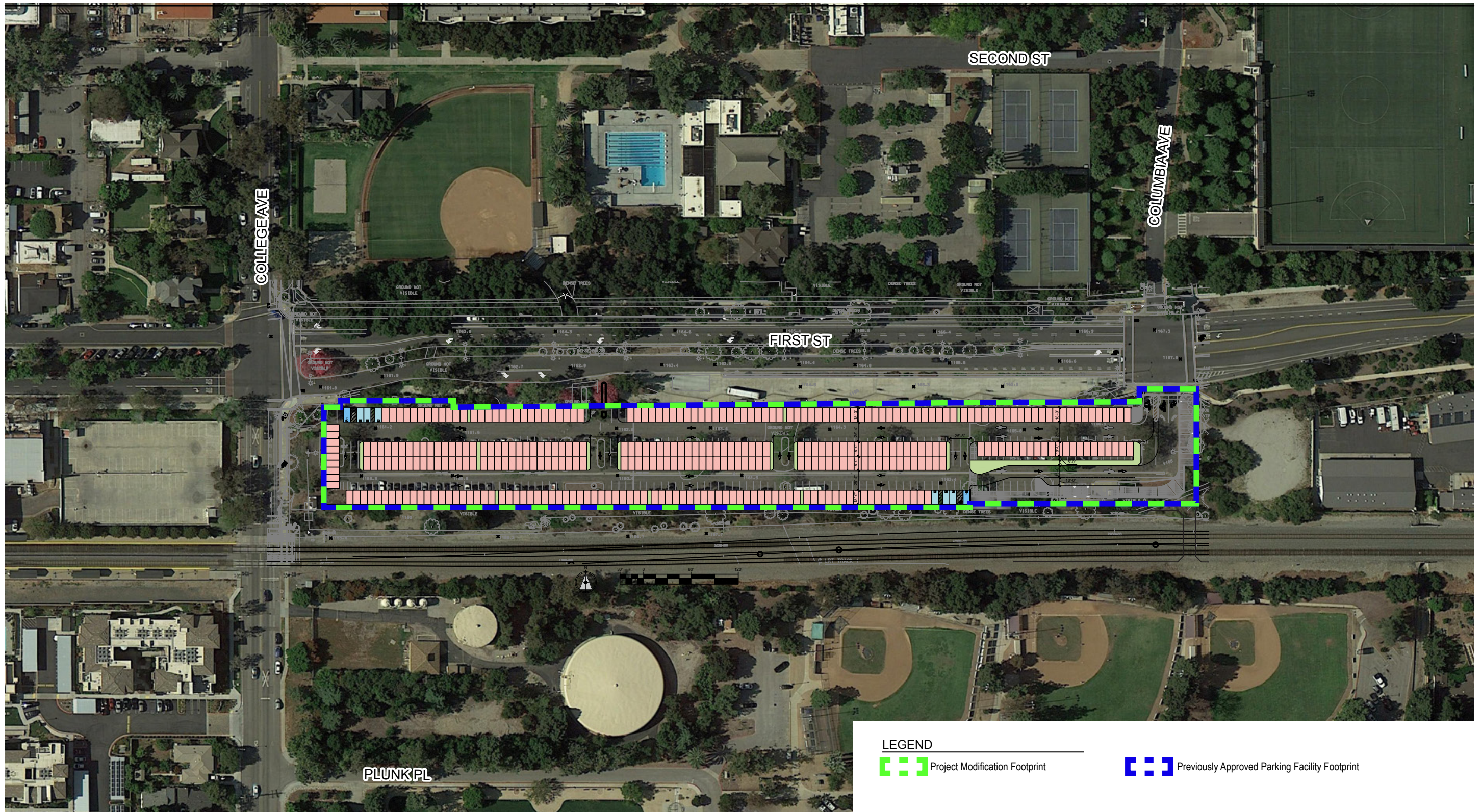


Figure NOP-6a

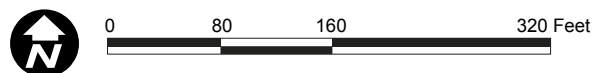


Figure NOP-6b
