The substantial increase on the above line items were due to the following:

a) Opening of six (6) new Heavy Rail stations on June 12, 1999 which have only 18 days in operation for fiscal year 1999 against 366 days of operations for fiscal year 2000.

- b) Acquisitions of 438 new buses for fiscal year 2000.
- c) Because of the a and b above, the agency added 1,729 new employees in the Bus and Rail operations. Please refer to Form 404 Transit Agency Employee Form for additional information.
- Line 03 Fringe Benefits Decrease (\$68,073,645) -27.19% The decrease in line 03 (fringe benefits) of \$68,073,645 or -27.19% was due to the year-end adjustment by our independent auditors increasing the workers comp expense/reserve of \$52.8 million in fiscal year 1999. Since the agency is no longer self-insured, an adjustment to increase/decrease the workers compensation reserve for fiscal year 2000 is no longer necessary.
- Line 09 Casualty/liability Decrease (\$4,336,793) -12.95% The decrease in line 09 Casualty/liability cost of \$4,336,793 or -12.95% was due to the year-end adjustment in fiscal year 1999 increasing the PLPD reserves based on the recommendation from our independent auditors.
- Line 18 Depreciation Increase \$66,552,937 41.80%
 The increase in line 18 Depreciation of \$66,552,937 or 41.80% was due to transfer of completed Construction in Progress (CIPs) to the Enterprise Fund due to the completion of final phase of the Heavy Rail extension and additions of 438 new buses. The total fixed assets additions during fiscal year 2000 were as follows:

Allocation of actual revenue miles, passenger miles, and operating expenses between fixed and non-fixed guideways uses a modified VRM methodology.

The MTA first calculates the total actual vehicle revenue miles, which are reported on form 406, Line 08, column i, using the following source data:

- 1. Master trip file database for each shake-up (pick).
- 2. Service added/cancelled based on temporary (pink) letters.
- Service provided to special events (Santa Anita Race Track, Hollywood Bowl, etc.)
- 4. Lost service from Dispatchers' daily incident database.

Vehicle revenue miles on fixed guideway facilities are calculated by multiplying the number of trips operated by the applicable fixed guideway segment length. (Different lines, and different trips on the same line, may use different portions of a single fixed guideway.) All fixed guideway mileage occurs in UZA 2. Vehicle revenue miles in UZA 63 are calculated by multiplying the number of trips operated by the applicable non-fixed guideway segment length. Non-fixed guideway vehicle revenue miles in UZA 2 are calculated by subtracting fixed guideway miles and UZA 63 miles from total actual vehicle revenue miles.

Operating expense is calculated by the simple VRM methodology: NF-63-VRM = 171,815

Total passenger miles (form 406, line 25, column i) are estimated by multiplying total daily boardings by the average trip length for each day type (weekday, Saturday, Sunday). Passenger miles occurring in UZA 63 are calculated separately, using automated passenger counters, and subtracted from total passenger miles to yield UZA 2 passenger miles. UZA 2 passenger miles are then allocated between fixed and non-fixed guideway based on the VRM methodology.

All MTA bus routes operate in UZA 2, but part of one route also operates in UZA 63. All fixed guideway service is within UZA 2. The calculation of total actual vehicle revenue miles and total passenger miles is explained in Form 005, Fixed/non-fixed guideway allocation methodology (Form 901).

UZA 63 actual vehicle revenue miles are calculated by multiplying the number of trips operated by the applicable non-fixed guideway segment length. All remaining vehicle revenue miles occur in UZA 2.

UZA 63 passenger miles are calculated from automated passenger counts by multiplying passengers on board by the distance to the next stop within UZA 63. All remaining passenger miles occur in UZA 2.

UZA 63 operating expense is calculated by the VRM method. The full calculation is shown in Form 005, Fixed/non-fixed guideway allocation. All remaining operating expense is attributed to UZA 2.
