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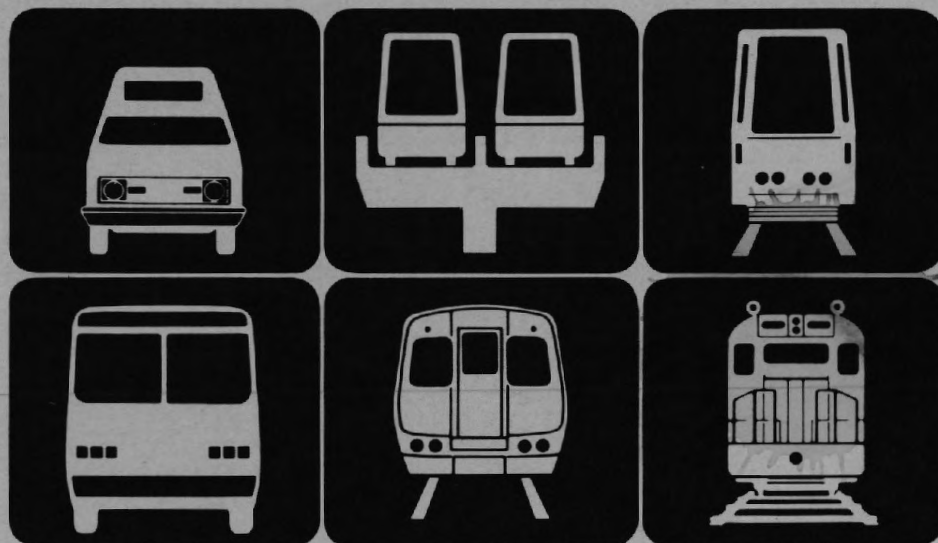

INTRODUCTION

This insert is divided into two sections, both of which are intended to make the report more usable to a broad cross-section of readers.

The **Index of Terms** lists, by data item, the page numbers in Sections 1 and 2 where these data items can be found. For example, if one were looking for fringe benefit information, this item can be found in two areas of the report, as shown in the index.

The **Data Guide** lists, alphabetically by State and, within a State, alphabetically by city, the page numbers in Section 2 where particular data items can be found for each of the 319 transit agencies included in this report. Within a city, agencies are listed in ascending order by total fleet size.
