MTA TO HOLD COMMUNITY MEETING IN EAST LOS ANGELES TO DISCUSS POSSIBLE FARE AND SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS

The MTA is encouraging residents of East Los Angeles to attend a special community meeting to learn more about the MTA's upcoming public hearing on proposed changes to fares and transportation service.

The community meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 18, 1994, at 6 p.m. at Resurrection Church, 3324 Opal Street, Los Angeles.

The session is designed to provide as much information as possible to interested citizens prior to a formal public hearing scheduled for Saturday, April 23, 1994, at 10 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Hall of Administration, 500 W. Temple Street, in downtown Los Angeles.

Several fare and service changes and alternatives are to be considered by the MTA Board of Directors, each of which will be discussed in detail at a series of community meetings. The public will be encouraged to ask questions and make comments; however, formal public input will be received only at the April 23 public hearing or in writing.
