MTA TO DISCUSS PLAN TO RESUME TUNNELING BENEATH HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD; TUNNEL OPEN TO MEDIA

WHAT:

MTA rail construction executives will present their technical plans to resume tunneling beneath Hollywood Boulevard later this month. Following the briefing, a limited number of media will have an opportunity to descend into the excavation pit and travel along the tunnel to the area under Hudson Avenue. Media wishing to see the bottom of the pit and the tunnels must first get a safety briefing and wear safety equipment, which will be provided. The safety briefing and tunnel tour will

take about two hours.

During the briefing -- drawings illustrating construction procedures; overview of the excavation pit. During the tunnel tour -- the interior of the tunnel, from Barnsdall Park west to

Hudson Avenue.

The number of seats on the tunnel train is limited. If the

number of interested media exceeds the capacity of the train, then a pool may be imposed. The tunnel is a dirty, wet place.

Work pants are recommended, and hard-soled shoes are

mandatory.
