L.A. SCHOOL KIDS RAP FOR MTA, RAIL SAFETY

- WHAT: Student winners of a rail safety contest sponsored by MTA and the Los Angeles Clippers will perform winning rap songs, read essays and poetry, and display posters, all promoting rail safety.
