MTA MOVES WILSHIRE CORRIDOR METRO INFORMATION OFFICE TO NEW LOCATION BETWEEN FUTURE RED LINE STATIONS

The MTA recently marked the opening of its new Wilshire Corridor Metro Red Line Information Office now centrally located at 3329 Wilshire Boulevard at Catalina Street between the future Wilshire/Vermont and Wilshire/Normandie Metro Red Line stations.

"Anyone interested in getting information about the progress of construction, or any other facts and figures about the Metro Red Line project, is invited to stop in our new field office," said Franklin White, MTA's chief executive officer.

Brochures, construction schedules, station layouts, route maps and other information are available to the public. There are also displays featuring Metro Rail construction photographs, archeological findings and public art.
