MTA TO REROUTE BUS LINES ALONG L.A. MARATHON ROUTE MARCH 5

MTA will temporarily reroute 70 Metro Bus lines in Los Angeles and Hollywood during the running of the 10th annual Los Angeles Marathon on Sunday, March 5, 1995.

The reroutings will occur at intervals between 5 a.m. and 4 p.m. on March 5 in downtown Los Angeles, Hollywood, Mid-Wilshire and Exposition Park. The earlier start time for reroutings is due to the Marathon bicycle tour, which begins at 6:30 a.m. and finishes prior to the start of the Marathon.

MTA Metro Bus patrons are advised to plan their trips early and obtain a brochure with specific information aboard Metro Buses in the affected areas, or call (800) COMMUTE.
