TRAFFIC ADVISORY

The Pasadena Freeway from its northern terminus in Pasadena south to the Avenue 60 exit will be subject to lane closures the evenings of March 22 and 23 between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. the next morning to allow reconstruction of the Arroyo Seco Bridge.

MARCH 22: On the southbound side, the right lane will close at 7 p.m., followed by the center lane at 11 p.m. and the left lane at midnight. On the northbound side, the right lane will close at 8 p.m. All lanes will reopen at 5 a.m.

MARCH 23: On the southbound side, the right lane will close at 7 p.m., followed by the center lane at 11 p.m. and the left lane at midnight. On the northbound side, the right lane will close at 8 p.m., followed by the center lane at midnight, and the left lane, from the Avenue 60 exit to the Orange Grove Avenue exit, at 2:30 a.m. All lanes will reopen at 5 a.m.

The Arroyo Seco Bridge is being reconstructed to make it earthquake safe for the new Pasadena Blue Line. The reconstruction will preserve the historic bridge's original appearance.
