NOTE NEW DATES

The Pasadena Freeway from its northern terminus in Pasadena south to the Avenue 60 exit will be subject to lane closures the evening of March 28 between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. the next morning to allow reconstruction of the Arroyo Seco Bridge.

On the southbound side, the right lane will close at 7 p.m., followed by the center lane at 11 p.m. On the northbound side, the right lane will close at 8 p.m., followed by the center and left lanes at midnight, from Avenue 60 to Orange Grove Avenue. All lanes will reopen at 5 a.m.

The Arroyo Seco Bridge is being reconstructed to make it earthquake safe for the new Pasadena Blue Line. The reconstruction will preserve the historic bridge's original appearance.
