MTA WORKSHOP ON METRO RED LINE EAST SIDE EXTENSION FOR COMMUNITY MEMBERS OF REVIEW ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHAT:

Forty-two representatives of the East Side area, located between Little Tokyo, Montebello and the City of Commerce, will attend a workshop to acquaint them with issues regarding the East Side extension of the Metro Red Line. The 42 community leaders are members of the Review Advisory Committee which will enhance communication between the MTA and the community.

The purpose of the workshop is to help prepare committee members for their role as advisors. They will take part in discussions conducted by MTA executives and engineers to learn about the project from various perspectives, such as engineering, real estate, and construction. Elected officials of

the community are also invited.
