EVENT:	The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority, the Federal Transit Administration and Northrop Grumman Corporation will hold a press conference to unveil the first "stealth" bus, a low-floor, light-weight bus manufactured with materials similar to those used in the famous U. S. Air Force bomber. Hundreds of engineers and transit officials along with U. S. Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, California Sen. Barbara Boxer and other officials will attend the rollout at the Northrop Grumman facility in El Segundo. The vehicle has been designed to be the transit bus of the 21 st Century due to its light-weight which allows the use of clean fuel power plants such as Compressed Natural Gas and electric fuel cells.
