JAMES DOOLIN INSTALLS MURALS AT MTA'S GATEWAY PLAZA

WHAT: A once-in-a-life-time opportunity to observe the installation of three major murals by James Doolin, portraying stages of development of Los Angeles and its transit systems from 1910 to beyond 2000.
