MTA TO OPERATE SPECIAL SHUTTLE BUS TO ROSE BOWL

ROUND TRIP FARE: \$1.00 OR ONE TOKEN FROM UNION STATION TO THE ROSE BOWL, SUNDAY, APRIL 28.

MTA will operate a special shuttle bus from Patsaouras Plaza at Union Station in downtown Los Angeles to the Rose Bowl for the Los Angeles Galaxy-San Jose Clash Major League Soccer Game, this Sunday, April 28.

Buses will leave as required from the Patsaouras Plaza for the Rose Bowl, starting at 1:30 p.m. until game time at 4:30 p.m., and return to Union Station after the end of the game until 8 p.m.

Patsaouras Plaza is located at Cesar Chavez Avenue and Vignes Street at the Eastern entrance to the Metro Red Line Union Station.

The round-trip fare will be \$1.00 cash or one token. No passes or transfers will be accepted.

"The shuttle is a service for all soccer fans who want to attend Major League Soccer," said Joseph Drew, MTA Chief Executive Officer. "But we are pleased to offer a particular convenience for soccer fans who also want to attend the Fiesta Broadway in downtown Los Angeles this Sunday.
