## ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD OF METRO RED LINE'S EAST SIDE EXTENSION FROM UNION STATION TO LORENA STREET

WHAT: The MTA will hold a public hearing on a Modified Initial Study/ Environmental Assessment which evaluates the environmental impact of East Side Metro Rail Red Line Extension from Union Station to Lorena Street. In addition, 2,500 notices of availability of the study were mailed, in English and Spanish, to interested parties, property owners and residents immediately effected by the proposed project.
