WHAT:

Introductory session:

Some 165 eleventh and twelfth graders from LAUSD schools will meet their MTA mentors for the summer employment program. The students are all participants in the Transportation Careers Programs sponsored by the MTA to help prepare young people for jobs in the transportation industry.

The students will work 30 hours a week, for six weeks, starting July 7. They are selected for the summer program by school career advisors and school counselors. Generally, they are students who have expressed an interest in engineering, urban planning, and architecture.

On Wednesday morning, they will take part in an orientation program and meet the MTA staff who will supervise their work for the summer.
