## MTA PREPARES BUS AND TRAIN CONTINGENCY PLAN IN CASE OF WALKOUT BY LABOR UNIONS

In case there is a work stoppage by any of the MTA's three major unions, the Authority has prepared a bus and rail service contingency plan to provide as much service as possible, with up to 350 buses on 41 key routes, as well as train service on the Metro Red, Blue and Green lines.

Currently, the agency is negotiating with unions representing approximately 6,300 MTA rail and bus operators, maintenance employees and clerks. All parties are seeking an agreement before midnight June 30, when current contracts expire. While the unions could call a strike at that time, the negotiations can continue beyond the deadline without a work stoppage as long as progress is being made.

"We sincerely hope there will not be a walkout, but if one occurs we will provide as much service as we can to help our patrons," said Interim MTA CEO Linda Bohlinger. She added that the MTA could implement its contingency plan as early as July 1, if there is a strike.

The MTA plan provides partial service on some of the Authority's busiest lines between the hours of 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily. Service on the rail lines will operate during the same time period seven days a week.

The fare on the bus and trains will be 50 cents cash. No transfers will be sold or issued. Senior citizens and the disabled will be charged 25 cents.

The sale of monthly passes will be suspended, however, tokens will continue to be sold. Passes purchased during the month of issue will be honored for the remainder of that month.

Transfers by other municipal carriers and Metrolink will be valid on all operating MTA buses and trains.

"We intend to operate a limited regional network of Metro Bus service during any work stoppage," added Bohlinger. "We ask our passengers to be especially patient. If there is a long walkout, we will add more service on additional lines to help reduce the impact of a strike."

All buses scheduled to operate will be MTA buses. They will be operated by MTA supervisory staff, MTA volunteers, contract operators, and temporary staff. All are fully licensed to operate a bus or train.

"Everyone who operates a bus or train during a walkout will be qualified for that task," Bohlinger said.

Train service on the Metro Blue, Green and Red Line will be less frequent than normal. During a work stoppage, Metro Blue Line trains are scheduled to run every 8½ minutes during rush hours, and every 12 minutes during the remainder of the day. Saturdays and Sundays service will operate about every 21-30 minutes. Metro Blue Line service will not operate south of the Willow Street station. MTA passengers are asked to travel to Willow by Long Beach services, and transfer to the Metro Blue Line there.

Metro Green Line service is scheduled to run every 30 minutes daily, including Saturdays and Sundays.

Metro Red Line weekday trains will operate every 10 minutes during peak hours and every 16 minutes the remainder of the day. Weekend service will operate every 16 minutes.

Metrolink service will continue to operate normally.

According to Bohlinger, "Our goal in these negotiations is to achieve fair and equitable contracts with the unions which will enhance MTA's flexibility, competitiveness, and efficiency. This will not only benefit our

customers and the taxpayers but, ultimately, our employees, as well."
