MTA KICKS OFF "TRY TRANSIT WEEK" WITH DEMONSTRATION OF 40 YEARS IN ENGINEERING ADVANCEMENT IN TRANSIT BUSES

WHAT:

MTA officials will mark the beginning of "Try Transit Week" by demonstrating 40 years in engineering advancement in transit buses, showing off a vintage 1958 GMC bus next to a new state-of-the-art Advanced Technology Transit Bus (ATTB). The MTA also will announce in-service testing of the new ATTB bus that will begin later this month in the greater Los Angeles area. The MTA and the Federal Transit Administration funded development of the bus. It is known as the Stealth Bus because the outer shell is made from composite materials, using design techniques developed for the B-2 Stealth Bomber. "Try Transit Week" is a national event designed to promote the use of public transit.
