## MTA HOSTS ONE DAY "SMART BUS" EXPO AT MTA HEADQUARTERS

WHAT: MTA is hosting a one day Intelligent Transportation System (ITS)

> "Smart Bus" Expo designed to provide an educational forum for transit agencies and ITS vendors to discuss and share information on developing

uniform standards for implementing an advance transportation

management system to create a "Smart Bus."

"Smart Bus" (ITS) technological equipment will be on display such as the Global Positioning System and the Automatic Vehicle Location system which use satellite technology to track bus movements along their assigned routes. Automatic passenger counters, video surveillance equipment, and automatic voice annunciators also will be on display. In addition, three buses which MTA has tested with "Smart Bus" technology will be on hand on the Gateway Plaza for visitors to observe this technology's practical applications. "Smart Bus" technology improves fleet performance, service quality, and passenger/operator safety through an integrated multi-media communication and computerized database

system.
