MTA SETS THIRD ROUND OF COMMUNITY MEETINGS ON THE EIGHT TRANSIT OPTIONS FOR THE EASTSIDE TRANSIT CORRIDOR STUDY

WHAT: The Metropolitan Transportation Authority and its team of consultants will hold their third round of community meetings for the Eastside Transit Corridor Study where they will present their eight transit alternatives and the findings that will be presented to the MTA Board of Directors. These range from busways, light rail and subway serving the communities of Boyle Heights, East Los Angeles, Montebello, Pico Rivera and Whittier. In this round of community meetings, MTA will discuss the comparison of the evaluation criteria such as project cost, environmental issues and riderships in respect to the eight transit alternatives.
