NORTH HOLLYWOOD EXTENSION OF THE METRO RED LINE SUBWAY OFFICIALLY DEDICATED

WHAT: MTA will join federal, state and local elected officials in a dedication ceremony marking the completion of the new 6.3-mile North Hollywood extension of the Metro Red Line subway system linking downtown Los Angeles and Hollywood with the San Fernando Valley. Hundreds of invited dignitaries and guests will be on hand for the celebration. Following the ceremony, dignitaries and the media will take an inaugural train ride from the North Hollywood Station to the new Universal City Station where dignitaries will be entertained by various characters from Universal Studios. Service to the public starts Saturday, June 24.

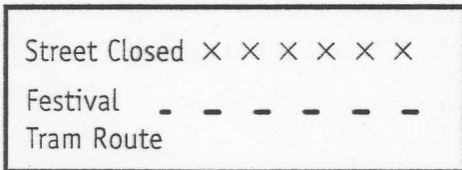
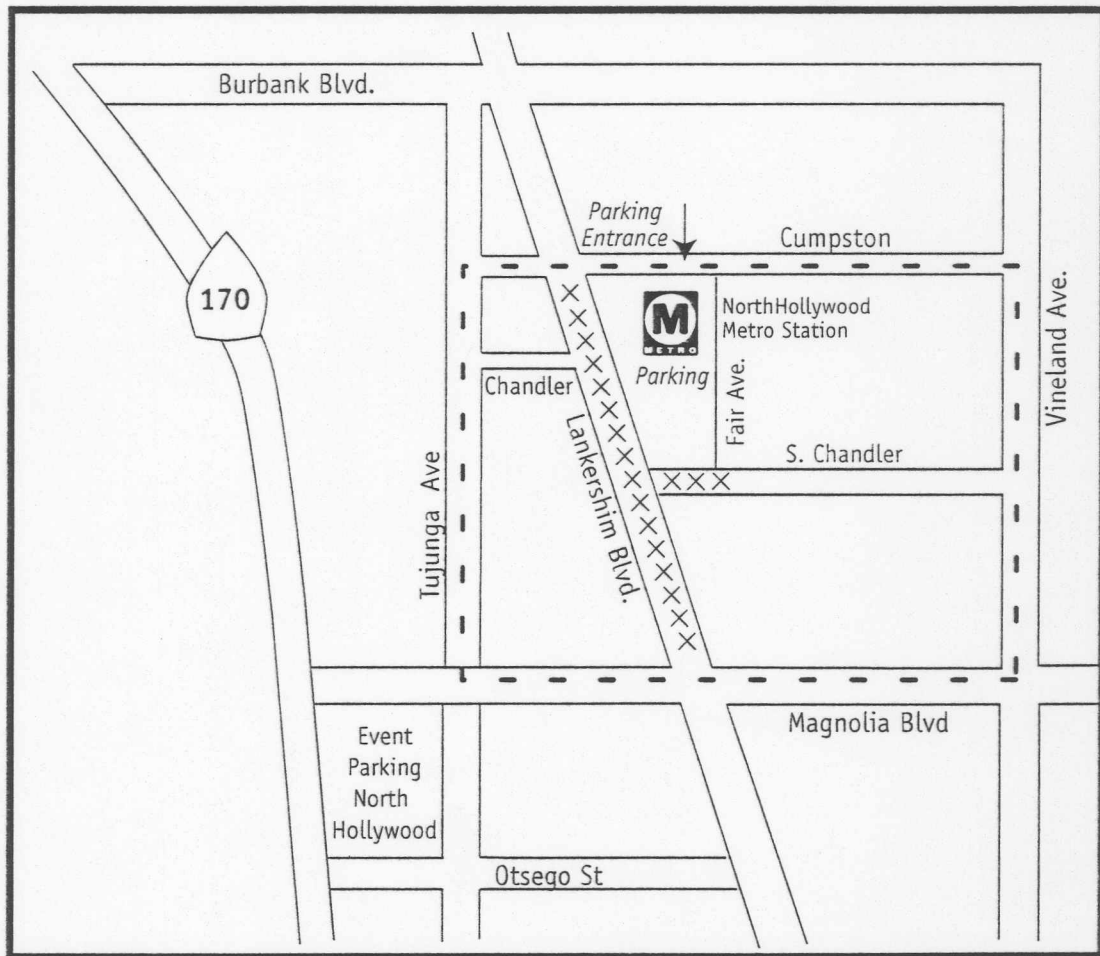
