Poetry in Motion® L.A. gets on board MTA Metro Rail for National Poetry Month

# Poets to stage live readings at rush hour at Union Station and on board Metro Rail subway, trains and stations

- Breaking through the rush hour monotone, acclaimed L.A.-based poets will be riding the rails, lifting the heart, and inviting Metro Rail riders to cherish the moment in celebration of National Poetry Month.
- FIRST READING: Union Station East Portal Friday, April 5, 4 to 6 p.m.

In a transit system brimming with visual splendor created by the artists and architects of 50 Metro Rail stations and the Gateway Transit Center at Union Station, another muse is soothing the soul of Los Angeles commuters.

In celebration of National Poetry Month in April, 15 acclaimed poets are staging live readings of poetry in the Metro system at rush hour from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m., beginning with a staged reading in the East Portal of Union Station on Friday, April 5, and on board the Metro Red Line, Blue Line and Green Line on the following three consecutive Tuesdays. The readings are a collaborative effort of the Poetry Society of America and MTA as part of the current *Poetry in Motion® L.A.* literary arts program on board Metro Buses.

Featured are readings by Elena Karina Bryne, noted poet and the regional director of the Poetry Society of America, as well as acclaimed L.A.-based poets Chris Abani, Briony Bax, George Chacon, Jennifer Kwon Dobbs, Amy Gerstler, Eloise Klein Healy, Larry Jaffe, John Kovatch, Gina Lain, Suzanne Lummis, Ellyn Maybe, Aleida Rodríguez, Antonieta Viallamil and Stephen Yenser.

Admission to each event is free, although valid fare is required to travel on Metro Rail for the readings on April 9, 16, and 23.

Continuing to find new and expressive ways of integrating art into the transit experience, MTA Metro Art has re-ignited a fiery union of public transit and *Poetry in Motion® L.A.* to produce a moveable feast of live readings by the acclaimed poets whose work appears throughout the year on placards installed in some 2,258 Metro Buses.

Co-sponsored by MTA and the Poetry Society of America, the readings personify and extend the experience of *Poetry in Motion* ® *L.A.* Over the life of the 2001-2002 series, more than 26,000 bus cards are inscribed with the works of 24 locally and internationally recognized poets and bring poetry to more than one million bus riders a day.

The literary arts program is supplemented by live readings during April and the distribution of some 120,000 bookmarks that replicate 11 of the poetry bus cards. The bookmarks are distributed on Metro Buses and Metro Rail trains and are available at Los Angeles County Libraries.
