Metro to Celebrate Anniversary of Expo Line Service between DTLA and Santa Monica

- WHAT:** Metro will mark the anniversary of the Metro Expo Line on Thursday, May 11. The light-rail line opened between downtown Los Angeles and Culver City in June 2012 and the extension to Santa Monica debuted to the public last May. The 15.2-mile Expo Line has been very successful with a total of 50 million-plus weekday boardings since 2012. Metro projected 64,000 average weekday boardings by the year 2030 — a number Expo seems poised to reach sooner with 59,931 weekday boardings this past March. After the event Metro officials will distribute cards to customers to participate in a drawing for a Metro Monthly pass.
