Happy Birthday, Metro!

L.A. Mayor Eric Garcetti, Other Local Officials to Commemorate 25 Years of Transportation Progress on Metro's 25th Anniversary

WHAT:	Los Angeles Mayor and Metro Board Chair Eric Garcetti will join a host of current and former Metro Board members and others to celebrate the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority's (Metro) 25 th anniversary. The agency was officially formed in February 1993 through a merger between the Southern California Rapid Transit District and Los Angeles County Transportation Commission. Over the last 25 years, Metro has built 82 additional miles of Metro Rail Lines, opened 22 new Bus Rapid Transit lines including the Metro Orange and Silver Lines, introduced ExpressLanes to regional freeways, and successfully passed two additional transportation sales tax measures that will continue to fund L.A. County's transportation revolution. A new agency "Time Capsule" will be assembled on stage at the celebratory event that will be unveiled for the agency's 50-year anniversary.
