LA County Supervisor and Metro Board Member Janice Hahn Joins Metro and Dodger Legends in Kicking Off Regular Season Dodger Stadium Express Bus Service For South Bay Fans From The Harbor Gateway Transit Center

- WHAT: LA County Supervisor and Metro Board Member Janice Hahn and Dodger legends Manny Mota and Mickey Hatcher will help Metro kick off the Dodger Stadium Express Bus Service from the Harbor Gateway Transit Center in the South Bay as the Los Angeles Dodger's 2018 baseball season begins with their season opener against the San Francisco Giants. The service is free to Dodger ticket holders. Last year over 241,000 baseball fans took advantage of the service with more than 1.4 million fans using the service since it began in 2010. Service is operated from both the Harbor Gateway Transit Center and Union Station. A Press Conference will be held at the Harbor Gateway Transit Center to celebrate getting the funding needed to continue the service from the South Bay location.
