L.A. Metro to Celebrate Unveiling, Naming of New Tunnel Boring Machines for Second Section of Purple Line Extension Project Underneath Beverly Hills and Century City

- What:** Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) officials, community members and other stakeholders will celebrate the unveiling of two new tunnel boring machines for Section Two of Metro's Purple Line Extension project, which will tunnel under Century City and Beverly Hills. Metro will also award local student prize winners for the new TBMs' naming and art contests. Starting early next year, there will be a total of four TBMs working simultaneously on Sections 1 and 2 of the project. Metro's entire 9-mile subway extension will connect Downtown Los Angeles to the Westside with fast, high-capacity transit service by 2027.
