# Tokens & Cash Fares

<u>Fare Type</u>	<u>Regular</u>	<u>S/D/M*</u>
• Tokens (sold in bags of 10)	\$1.10 ea	-
• Base Fare	\$1.25	\$0.45
• Zone Charges (per zone) **	\$0.50	\$0.25
• Metro Night Service (9 pm - 5 am)	\$0.75	\$0.35

\* S/D/M = Senior/Disabled/Medicare

\*\* Maximum 2 Zones Per Line



# Metro Passes

<u>Fare Type</u>	<u>Regular</u>	<u>S/D/M*</u>
• Day Pass (new as of 1/04)	\$ 3.00	\$ 1.50
• Weekly Metro Pass	\$14.00	-
• Semi-Monthly Metro Pass	\$27.00	-
• Monthly Metro Pass	\$52.00	\$12.00 **
• Student K-12	\$20.00	-
• College/Vocational	\$30.00	-
• EZ Pass	\$58.00	\$29.00
• Zone Stamp (Monthly/EZ Pass) (Per Zone)	\$15.00	\$ 7.50

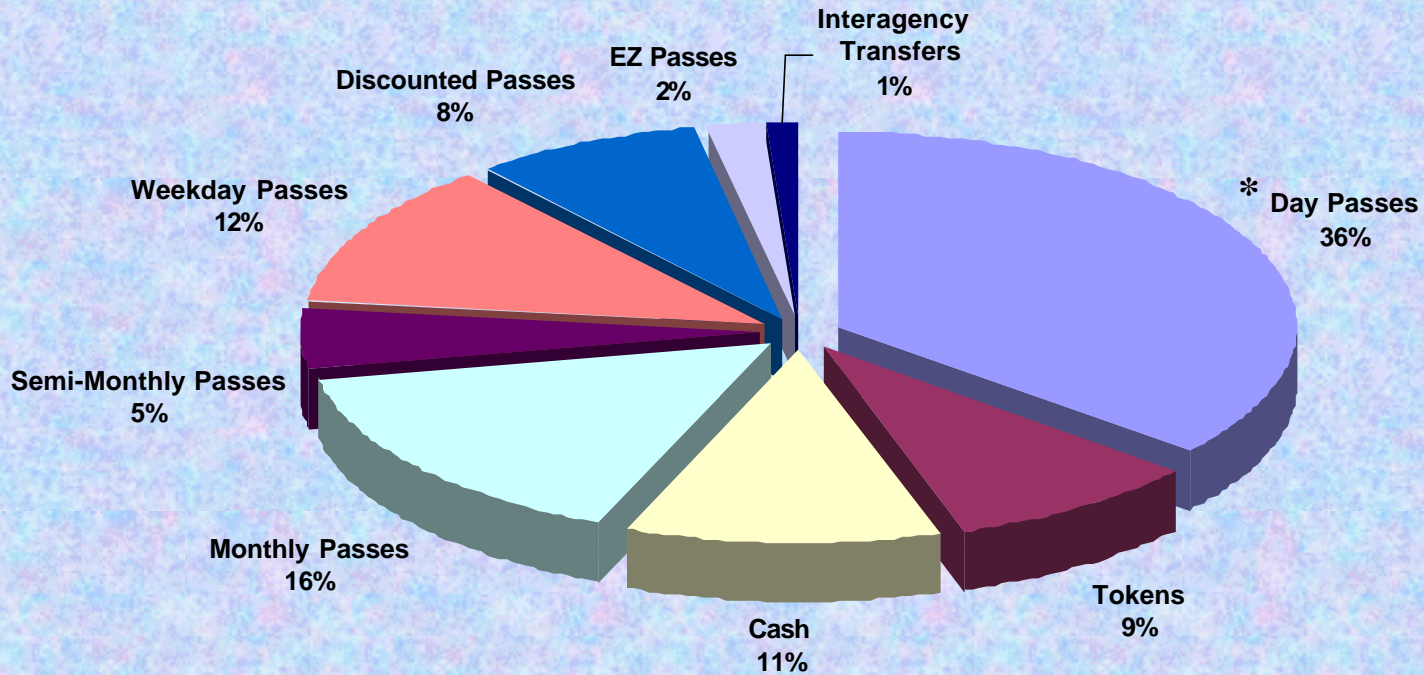
