



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON 2003 - 2004 CONFORMANCE
DETERMINATIONS OF LOCAL JURISDICTIONS WITH THE LOS ANGELES
COUNTY CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA) is holding a public hearing to consider the conformance and non-conformance determinations for the County of Los Angeles, and of cities within the County, with the requirements of the Los Angeles County Congestion Management Program (CMP). Conformance with the CMP is required by state statute in order for local jurisdictions to receive gas tax funds authorized by the voters pursuant to Proposition 111. This hearing is held in accordance with the California Government Code (paragraph (a), Section 65089.5), which specifies that prior to making any decision regarding the conformance of local agencies with the adopted CMP, the MTA shall hold a noticed public hearing to receive testimony from the affected local agencies and public. All comments received will be compiled and submitted to the MTA Board of Directors for their consideration prior to final determination of each local jurisdiction's conformance or non-conformance with the CMP. The final determination of the Board of Directors is scheduled to be made at their regular meeting scheduled for February 24, 2005.
