SUBJECT: PASADENA GOLD LINE PHASE II

STATUS: PENDING COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENT

ACTION: OPPOSE – WORK WITH AUTHOR

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Board of Directors adopt an **OPPOSE – WORK WITH AUTHOR** position on AB 1649.

#### **PROVISIONS**

This bill is virtually identical to AB 712 (Liu) on which the Board of Directors adopted an "oppose unless amended" position last June. This bill would:

- Rename the Los Angeles to Pasadena Metro Blue Line Construction Authority (Authority) to the Metro Foothills Gold Line Construction Authority;
- Rename the entire project from Union Station to Claremont to the Metro Foothills Gold Line;
- ➤ Require the voting membership of the board to consist of 5 members and one non-voting member appointee as follows:
  - o 2 members appointed by the LACMTA who shall be members of the LACMTA Board of Directors;
  - o 3 members appointed by a local selection committee composed of City Council representatives from the cities of Arcadia, Monrovia, Duarte, Irwindale, Azusa, Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne, Pomona, Pasadena, South Pasadena and Claremont;
  - o 1 non-voting member appointed by the Governor;
- State that the board members may be removed at any time by the appointing authority; and
- > State that the bill is not intended to affect local, state or federal funding priorities.

#### The remainder of the statute:

- > Requires that the Exposition Line and the Foothills Extension be constructed in phases and according to a specified schedule.
- Requires the LACMTA to prepare a financial plan which would fund each project according to the specified schedule.
