Orange Line Update



Metro Orange Line continues to be a great success!

- Ridership remains high – 16,100 Daily in January ; rising to 17,636 daily in February
 - 10,576 Saturdays (60% Weekdays)
 - 8,496 Sundays (48% weekdays)
- There were NO collision accidents on the busway in March

Orange Line Update

The Interagency Safety Task force continues to meet, evaluate, and implement recommended changes. Current focus on:

- DRIVE CAM™ Installation complete
- Operator retraining completed
- Interactive safety DVD & PSA's to be released this spring; filming completed 2/27/06
- Implementation of photo enforcement at 12 intersections (June 2006); contract with ACS to be approved in April 2006. The board request will include an option to cover the remaining 23 locations.
- 23 additional locations to be outfitted with bus coming LED signs (July 2006)
- LAPD and LASD continuing strong enforcement, including focus on pedestrian movements
- Intersection slow-order to remain in effect

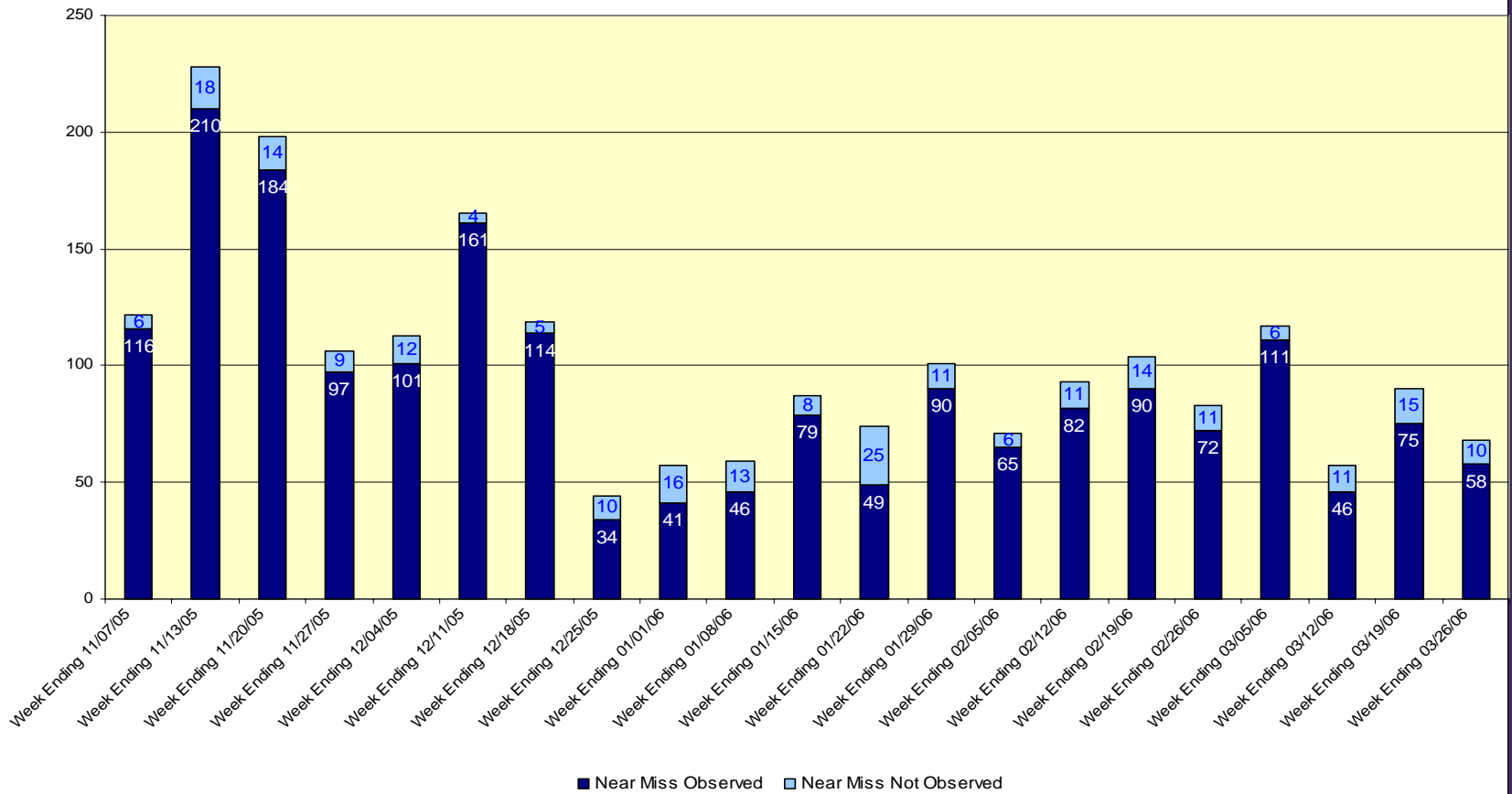

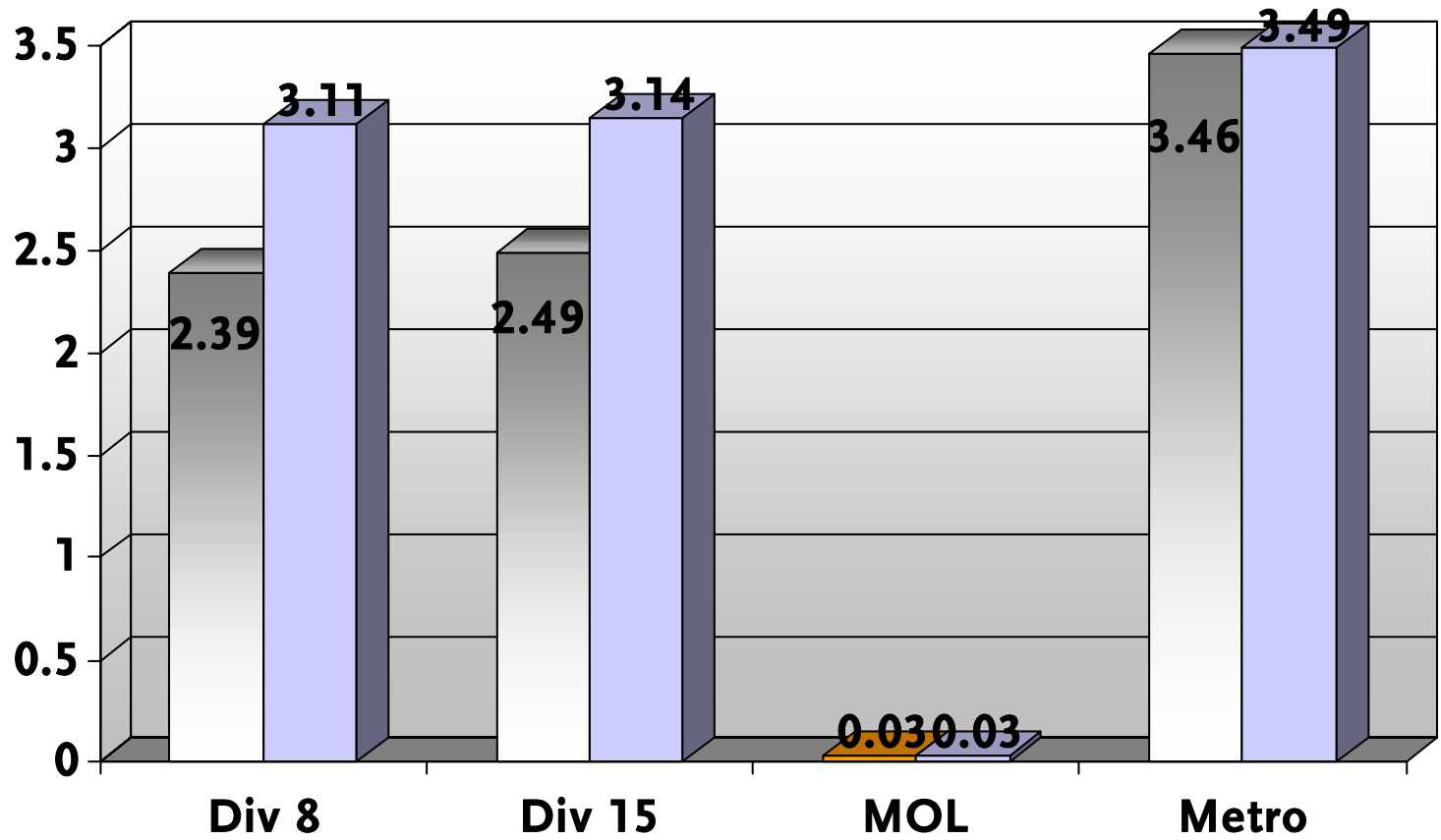
Observed Near Misses 11/04/05 Thru 3/26/06

11/04/05 to 03/26/06



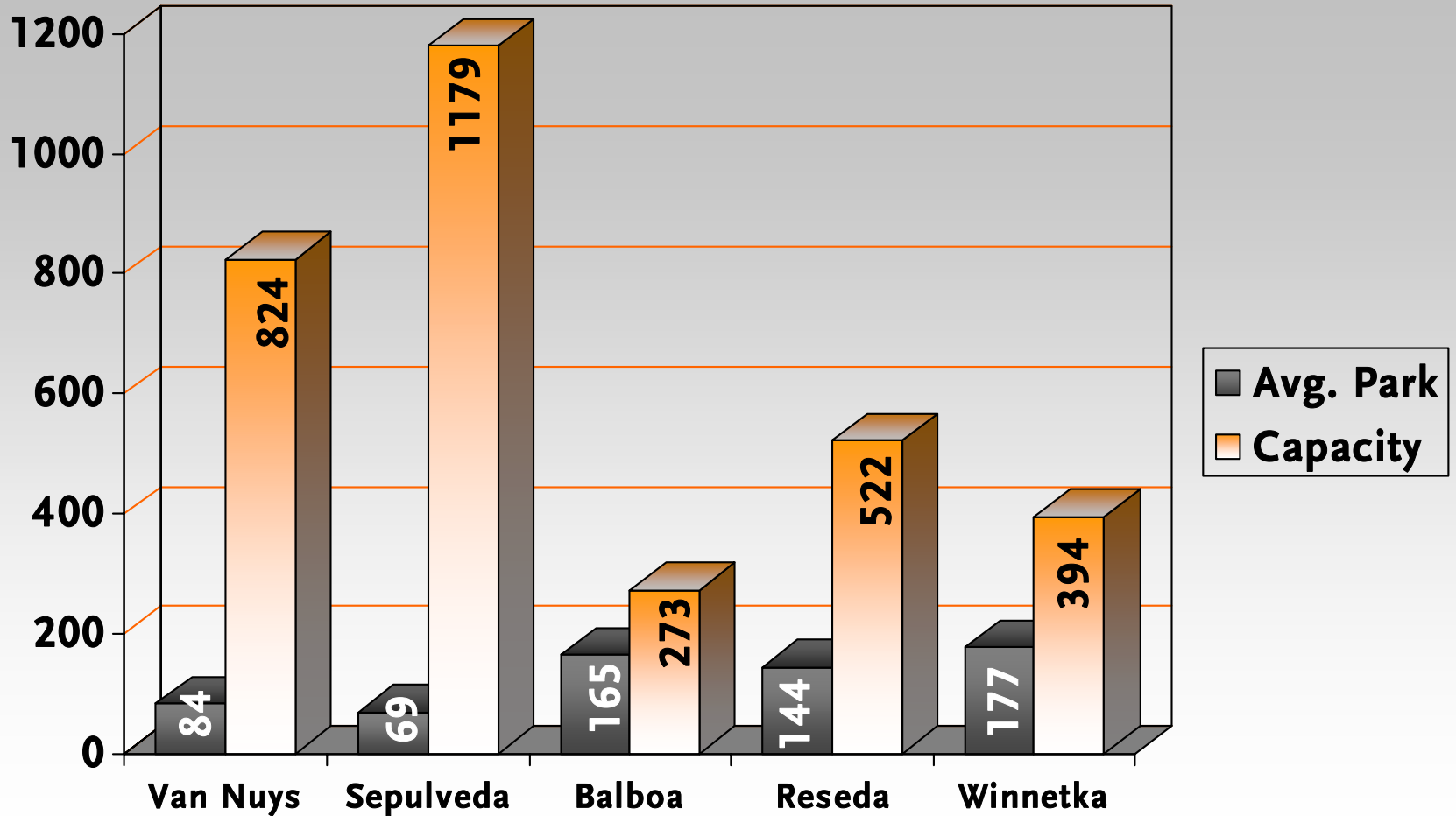
February Accidents / 100,000 Scheduled Miles
