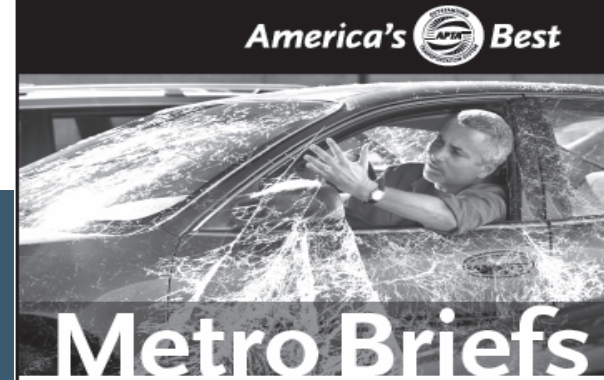

Development Planned Along Eastside Extension

Metro is currently in negotiations for the development of 43 housing units, retail space, community rooms and parking for 94 cars at 1st and Lorena streets near the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension. The area is near the Indiana Station of the rail line scheduled to be opened in 2009.

El Monte/Gold Line Connection On Line 287

The Sierra Madre Villa Metro Rail Station in Pasadena now links with El Monte Station via Metro Local Line 287. The new line also connects at the Gold Line with Line 487 serving MacArthur Park via downtown LA to Union Station. Find out more at metro.net.

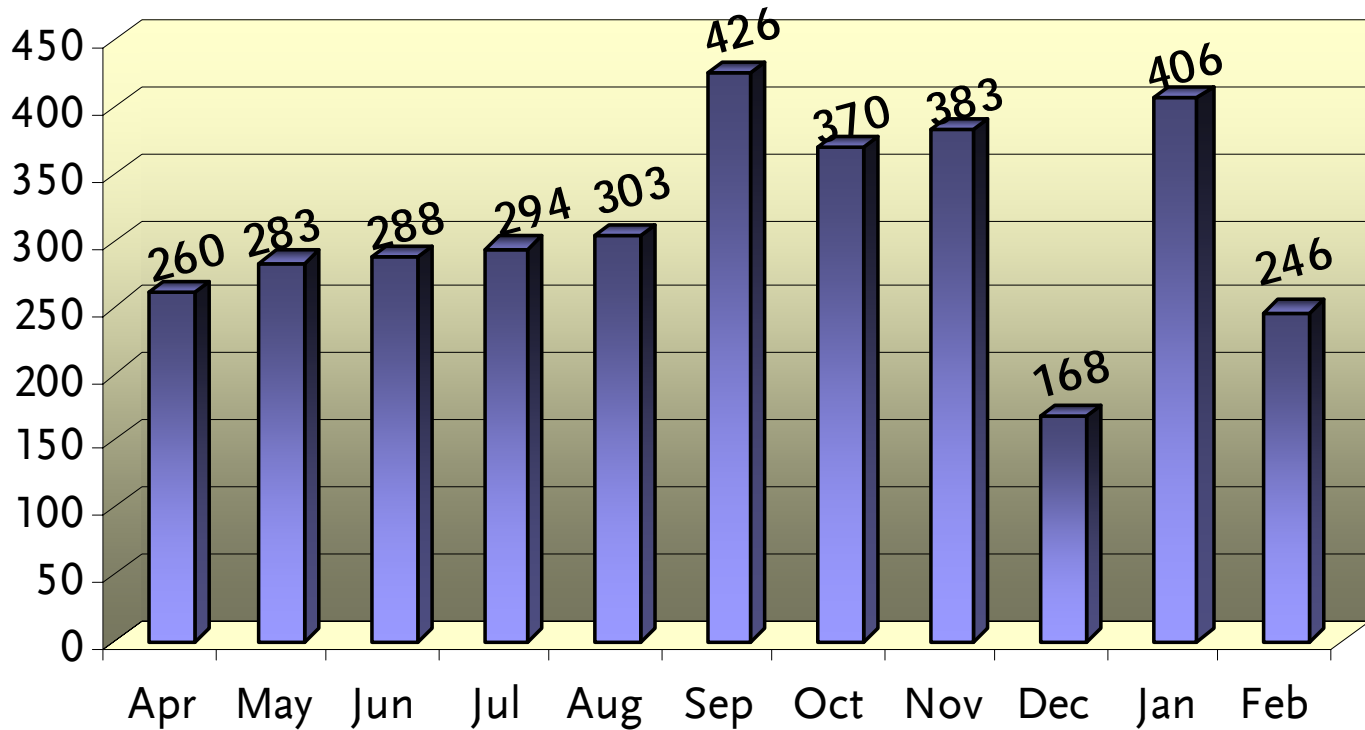

April 2006 - February 2007



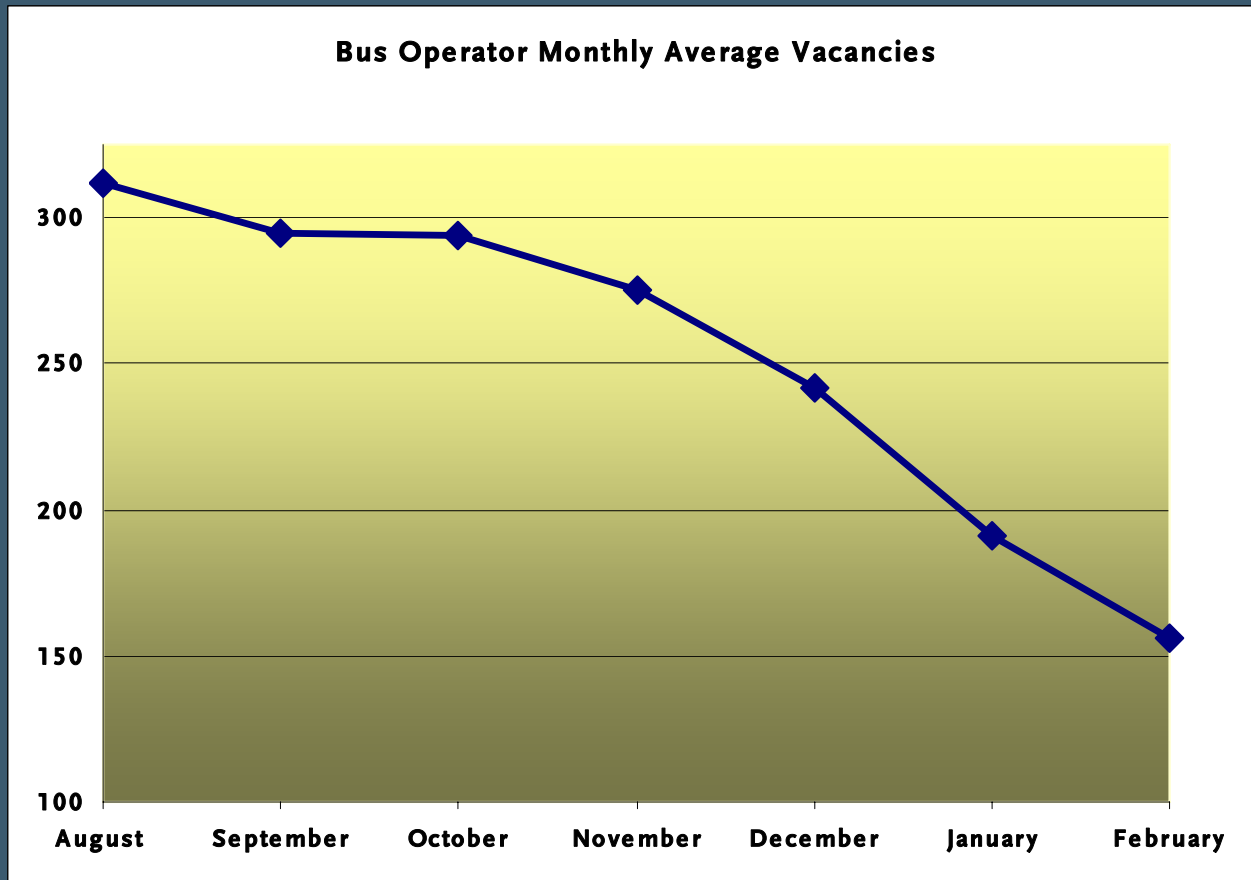
