SUBJECT:

PROPOSED CHANGES TO METRO BUS SERVICE

ACTION:

APPROVE PROPOSED CHANGES TO TIER 1 BUS SERVICE

RECOMMENDATION

Approve service changes to Tier 1 bus lines scheduled to be implemented in June 2007.

ISSUE

The existing Service Sector Governance Council Policy states that service changes to Tier 1 bus lines must be reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors prior to implementation. The Sector Governance Councils have reviewed and approved proposed service changes for June 2007 (See Attachment A), and staff is seeking board approval in order to implement changes as scheduled.

DISCUSSION

In preparation for the June 2007 Service Change, the Metro Service Sectors have developed proposed modifications to bus lines operating within their service area. The June 2007 Service Changes represent the first phase of Metro Connections implementation. Key themes of the program are attracting new riders by providing faster service and improving efficiency by reducing service in those corridors where there is low ridership and/or duplicative service. The changes being proposed for June 2007 include modifications to 12 of Metro's Tier 1 bus routes, as summarized below:

- Implementing Metro Rapid service on Long Beach and Santa Monica Boulevard;
- Implementing Metro Rapid Express service along Hawthorne and Wilshire Boulevard:
- Reducing or restructuring service due to low ridership and/or service duplication on six routes (20/21: Wilshire Boulevard,4/304: Santa Monica, 60/360: Long Beach, 710: Cresnhaw/Rossmore; 720: Wilshire, and 751: Soto) and
- Minor routing changes on two other services (10/11: Melrose and 3/316: Third Street)

Consistent with Federal requirements and agency policy, the proposals have been reviewed by the public during hearings held the week of February 05, 2007 and have subsequently been approved by their respective Governance Council with the exception of Lines 20/21 Wilshire Blvd. – UCLA Santa Monica. Staff recommendations on Line 20/21 had a majority of the Council in favor of the proposed changes. The conflict is one council member who lives close to Wilshire Boulevard who was encouraged to abstain from voting after consulting Metro's Ethic Department. Due to this potential conflict the Council fell short by one on the total votes required to approve, therefore, no action was taken and the proposal was deferred to the Board for final decision.

OPTIONS

The Board may decide to either approve a subset of the recommended changes or not approve the recommended service changes. However, this is not recommended as the proposals have been reviewed and approved by the Sector Governance Councils, and would have a negative impact on the FY07 Operating Budget.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The proposed changes have been included in the FY08 budget proposal that will be presented to the Board for approval and are consistent with the FY07 Ten-Year Forecast. If not implemented as presented, there would be an increase in annual operating costs or an offsetting reduction would be required elsewhere to mitigate budget impact. The impact would vary according to the specific proposals that were not approved.

POLICY IMPLICATIONS

The review process was conducted in accordance with the Transit Service Policy and the proposed service changes are consistent with Metro's Operating Budget, agency plans, agency policy and federal requirements.

NEXT STEPS

With Board approval, the service changes will be effective June 24, 2007. Staff will notify customers with on-board brochures describing service changes. Also, new timetables with schedule and route modifications will be available on Metro buses in early June.
