- 1. APPROVED **Minutes** of Board Meeting held February 1, 2006.
- 2. AUTHORIZED the Chief Executive Officer to exercise the contract option and to execute Modification No. 2 to Contract No. OP33201764 with Arieli Associates, to **provide technical consulting services** for a period of one year for an amount not to exceed \$200,000 increasing the total contract value from \$200,000 to \$400,000 in support of the Advanced Transit Vehicle Consortium (ATVC).

John Drayton, Manager, Vehicle Technology, provided a brief overview of how the contract has complied with the previous instructions of the ATVC Board. He explained that the one-year contract, which the ATVC Board authorized last year, is in the process of being completed. Mr. Drayton reported that to date, staff has spent \$139,000 of the \$200,000 available for this contract and anticipates that it will end the year under budget and on schedule. He reviewed attachment 1 of the Board report, which provides a summary of the work plan, and indicated that Dr. Arieli's work this past year has been consistent with the work plan, with most of his time allocated to the 2010 environmental regulations.

Mr. Catoe added that Dr. Arieli has spent additional hours assisting the agency with issues not directly related to vehicle technology. He noted that Dr. Arieli's testimony before the California Air Resources Board resulted in a delay in a regulation that would have been impossible for the agency to meet. The regulation stipulates that the agency purchase fuel cell buses over the next few years. He explained that not only is the technology not available, but this regulation would have cost the agency \$40 million per year. Dr. Arieli's testimony was particularly significant as other transit agencies were not testifying against the regulation.

Director Cano asked if it would be appropriate, in terms of self-funding and scope of work for this contract, to ask Dr. Arieli to look for new revenue sources, possibly grants or proposals for new technologies.

Chair Bohlke supported Director Cano's idea and mentioned that he would like to explore having this JPA, in conjunction with Metro, start working with groups such as SCAG, AQMD and the ports to examine goods movement issues.

He clarified that this is a new contract for \$200,000 and that while there was the authority to go up to \$200,000 in the last contract, the actual amount spent fell far short of this amount. The savings will roll back into the ATVC budget and is not part of Dr. Arieli's contract.

- 3. APPOINTED MTA Director Bonnie Lowenthal with Karen Heit as her alternate to replace Director Frank Roberts and Vivian Rescalvo to replace Samantha Bricker as alternate to Director Zev Yaroslavsky on the **ATVC Board**.
- 4. RECEIVED status update on **Bus Procurement Activities**:
 - A. Metro Bus Procurement Update
 - B. Advanced Technology Demonstration Projects
 - C. CARB Zero Emission Bus (ZEB) Regulations

Mike Bottone provided an overview of the 60-foot option order, gasoline hybrids, HCNG project, and CARB ZEB fleet rule. He reported that 30 buses have been delivered and accepted through the 60-foot option order, and all buses are on schedule to be delivered by June 30, 2007.

He stated that the price submitted by New Flyer for the procurement of gasoline hybrids (\$720,000 each) was 35% higher than the base order provided to Long Beach Transit, and staff has countered the proposal with a more reasonable price.

Chair Bohlke asked about what would happen if New Flyer does not respond adequately to the counter-proposal.

Mr. Bottone responded that we would need to make a decision at that time but he believes that we may move forward with the procurement.

With regard to the HCNG project, four test engines are currently undergoing baseline testing, and the HCNG version will be tested in mid-November.

He indicated that with respect to the CARB ZEB fleet rule, the requirement to purchase ZEB's is now deferred until 2012 for alternative path and 2011 for diesel path agencies. MTA has offered to work with CARB staff on further refinements of ZEB regulations that will be up for reconsideration in 2009.

5. AUTHORIZED Disposition of ATTB Test Vehicles.

Director Fasana inquired about flywheel testing conducted by Houston Metro.

Staff responded that this project was abandoned and that the buses were auctioned off for scrap.

Chair Bohlke noted that the ATTB brought us the Compo bus from NABI and hybrids from New Flyer. Dr. Arieli's team has decided to donate one ATTB test vehicle to Rio Hondo College.

Director Cano asked that his request to amend the scope of work to include securing other earmarks and grants be formally brought back to the Board for approval (refer to item #2). He mentioned that the AQMD representative, Beatrice LaPisto-Kirtley, no longer serves on the AQMD Board.

An AQMD representative indicated that the executive officer is working with the AQMD Board to determine who will replace Ms. LaPisto-Kirtley. The AQMD will forward a letter to the ATVC Board once a nominee is selected.

Chair Bohlke welcomed Ms. Rescalvo and Ms. Heit to the ATVC Board.
