SUBJECT: BUCKET TRUCKS

ACTION: AWARD CONTRACT FOR BUCKET TRUCKS

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to award a firm, fixed price contract under bid No. OP34342261 with Reynolds Buick/Pontiac/GMC Trucks, for two bucket trucks in an amount not to exceed \$283,097, inclusive of sales tax.

RATIONALE

After the initial bid evaluation, Victor Buick-GMC Truck, the apparent low bidder, informed us that it would be ceasing business operations and would not be able to complete this order, leaving two responsive bids.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The funding of \$283,097 for these items is included in the budget under cost center 3434, Non-Revenue Operations, Line Item 53106, Acquisition of Non-Revenue Equipment under Project 208007, Bus System Support Non-Revenue Vehicles.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

An alternative is to not purchase these bucket trucks and continue using the existing ones. This option is not recommended due to the age of the vehicles and their diminishing reliability. Additionally, CARB and SCAQMD have imposed exhaust after treatment modifications for this year of truck to reduce emissions. The cost associated for these devices far exceeds the value of the trucks.

DISCUSSION

This procurement is for the purchase of two bucket trucks, which will be used by bus operations for facility maintenance and repairs. These trucks have an articulating arm with a "bucket" that carries a technician, allowing them to access elevated areas not accessible by

conventional ladders or platforms. Ceiling lights, plumbing, electrical conduit and parking lot lights are common areas requiring this type of vehicle.

These two trucks have met our GEN-16 guideline of seven years and or 125,000 miles for replacement. To maximize equipment utilization, we have operated these trucks for 15 years. California Air Resource Board (CARB) and South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) is targeting this age of existing vehicles for government fleet replacement due to the emission deficiencies of this older engine technology.

BOARD REPORT ATTACHMENT A-1 PROCUREMENT HISTORY

BUCKET TRUCKS

A. Background on Contractor

Reynolds Buick/Pontiac/GMC Trucks, located in Covina, CA, has been in business for 93 years and its principal business is automobile sales and services. Reynolds Buick/Pontiac/GMC Trucks has been the successful bidder on previous Metro procurements and their performance on those procurements were satisfactory. Reynolds Buick/Pontiac/GMC Trucks has also done business with the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, Metropolitan Water District, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, and The Salvation Army.

B. Procurement Background

IFB No. OP34342261 was conducted as a two-phase “brand name or approved equal” procurement. Phase I provided potential bidders the opportunity to submit their requests for approved equals to the brand named vehicles and in Phase II, sealed bids were due with four bids received.

The Diversity and Economic Opportunity Department (DEOD) did not recommend a MBE/WBE Voluntary Anticipated Level of Participation (VALP) goal for this procurement due to lack of subcontracting opportunities.

C. Evaluation Criteria

In accordance with our Procurement Policies and Procedures, Non-Revenue Operations Quality Assurance Department performed a technical evaluation of the four bids received. Victor Buick-GMC Truck submitted two bids: Bid #1 with a Versalift aerial device and Bid #2 with a Terex model aerial device. Both bids were considered as responsive bids.

Reynolds Buick/Pontiac/GMC Trucks took exceptions to the pump type and mirrors of the vehicles, however, these deviations were determined to be minor informalities.

Altec Industries’ bid was in full compliance to our technical requirements.

After evaluation, it was determined that all bids were all considered responsive.

After evaluation, Victor Buick informed us it would be ceasing business operations, leaving two responsive bids. Reynolds Buick/Pontiac/GMC Trucks subsequently agreed to reduce its bid to meet the low bid price submitted by Victor Buick.

D. Cost/Price Analysis

The bid by Reynolds Buick/Pontiac/GMC Trucks is considered to be reasonable based on adequate competition in the marketplace.


