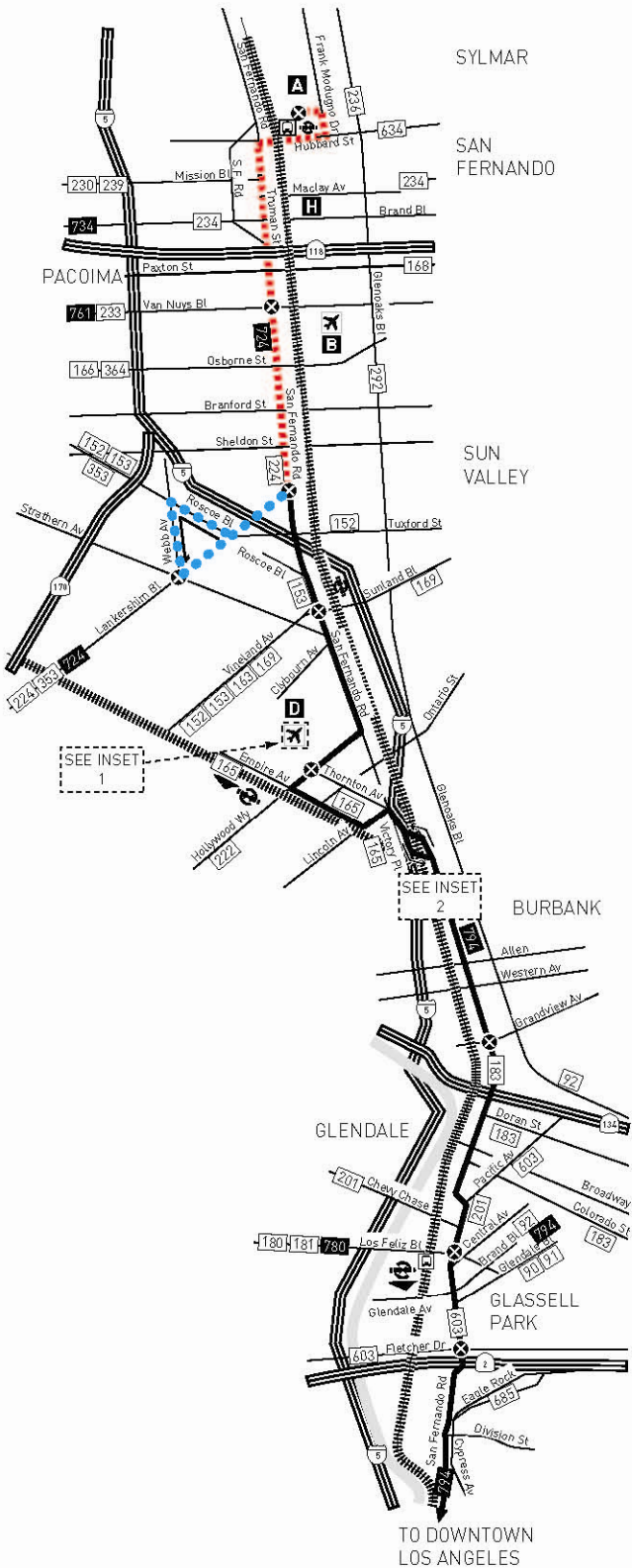

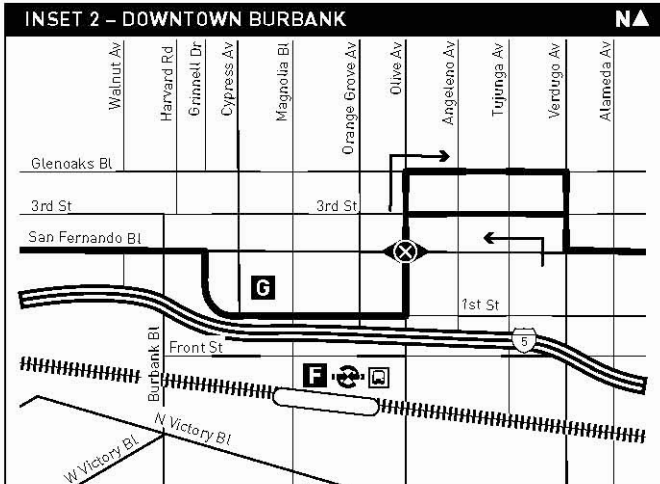

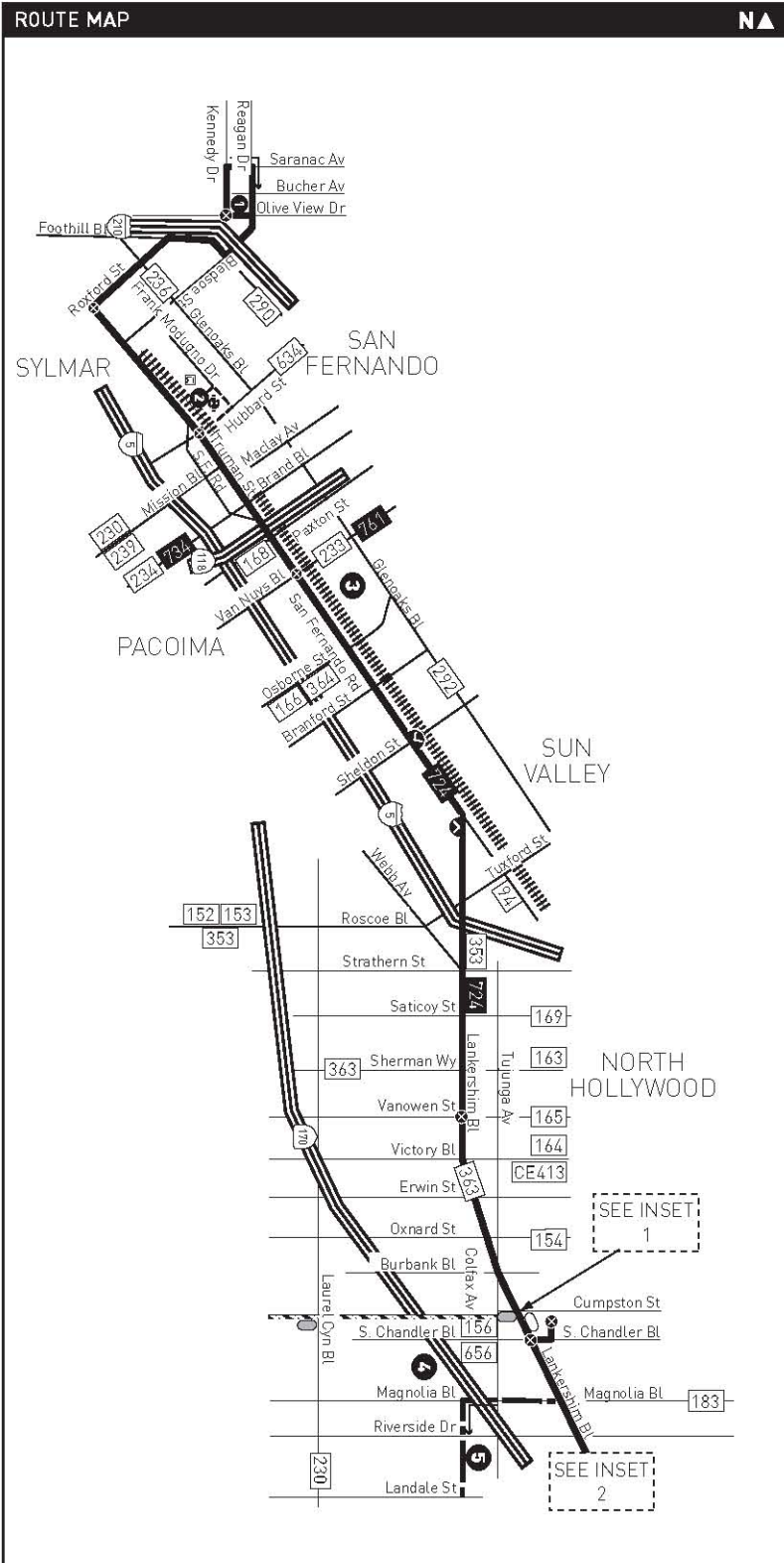
Shorten route to terminate in Sun Valley and reallocate resources to extend Line 794 to Sylmar Station.
