


## **COMPLETED MEASURES**

### **ENGINEERING**

- Closed at-grade crossings on Flower Street
- Installed "Four Quadrant Gates" and Vehicle Detection Loops at 6 intersections
- Replaced passive "No Left Turn" signs with active flashing "Train" Signs





- Installed median islands at several intersections
- Installed active "No Left" & "No Right" Turn signs at crossings



• Modified the traffic signal system in Los Angeles



Installed active "Look Both Ways" sign at Vernon Station





• Installed additional flashing lights and bells at several gated crossings




- Installed "Swing Gates" at several high-traffic pedestrian crossings
- Installed barriers (railroad-type gates) at several crossings







- Installed colored stamped crosswalks
- Installed pavement markings








- Installed a "Cyclops" light on all trains
- Changed the mechanical horn on the trains to an electronic horn
- Modified the headlights on all light rail trains to flash alternately
- Reduced the height of the right-of-way fencing at highway rail grade crossings
- Installed a 1.2 mile center fence in the City of Long Beach
- Replaced filament lights on warning devices with LED's





• Installed in-pavement warning lights





## **ENFORCEMENT**

- Installed photo enforcement cameras at grade crossings
- Initiated motor bike patrols by Transit Services Bureau
- Sponsored legislation that increased the citation for highway rail grade crossing violations
- Conducted targeted enforcement at high-risk crossings



#### **EDUCATION**

- Conducted yearly presentations to the 160 schools within a 1.5-mile radius of the alignment
- Developed Videos and CD's on safe and unsafe behaviors around tracks and trains
- Prepared site specific safety presentations videos
- Implemented the Safety Ambassador program



• Distributed 250,000 door hangers and safety information






## **OPERATIONS**

- Revised the defensive operating program
- Modified the operating speed for approaches to 'far-side' gated station crossings
- Revised the rule regarding use of train-borne audible device

## **FUTURE ACTIONS PLANNED**

- Install LED Pedestrian "TRAIN" signals in both Los Angeles and Long Beach crosswalks at street running Blue Line Station locations
- Install Swing Gates and pedestrian gates (railroad type gates) on the MTA and UPRR side of the right-of-way at gated crossings
- Install "LOOK BOTH WAYS" active signs at station crossings



Install an audible warning device (grade crossing bell) at non-gated station crossings





- Pilot In-Roadway Warning Lights (IRWLs) at 2 non-gated intersections
- Install suicide prevention signs at all stations and at high speed gated crossings

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- Install active TRAIN signs at non-gated crossings in Long Beach where left turns are prohibited
- Enhance the lighting at grade crossings
- Install blank out "No Right Turn"/ "No Left Turn" signs





- Install pavement markings at non-gated station crossings
- Wrap 20 Blue Line trains with safety messages





- Expand safety outreach & education efforts
- Reprint and redistribute safety door hangers
